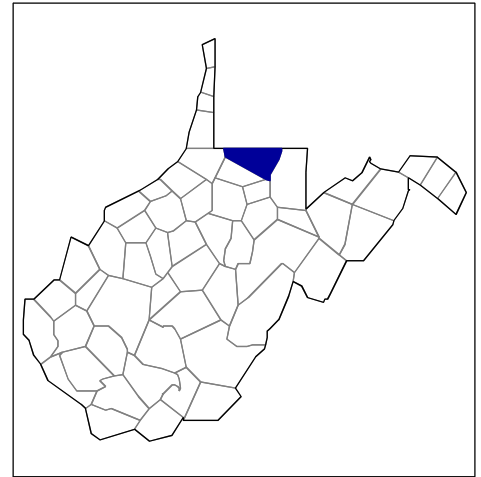

Market Value of Production, average per farm

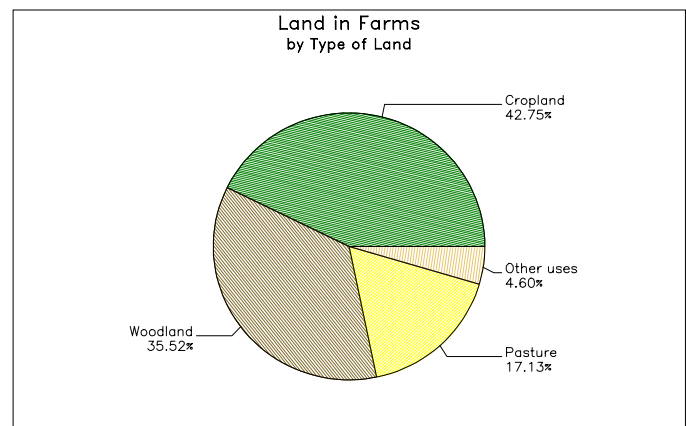
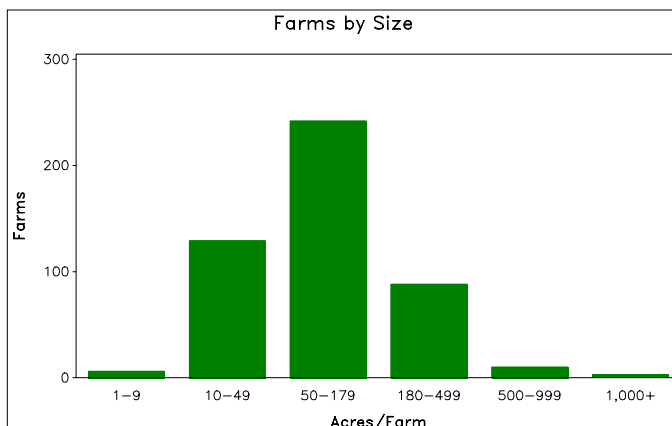
\$5,136 in 2002, \$5,736 in 1997, down 10 percent.
