### Market Value of Production, average per farm

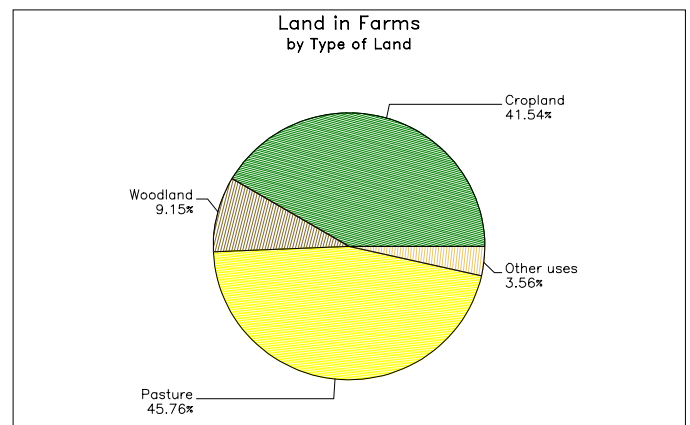
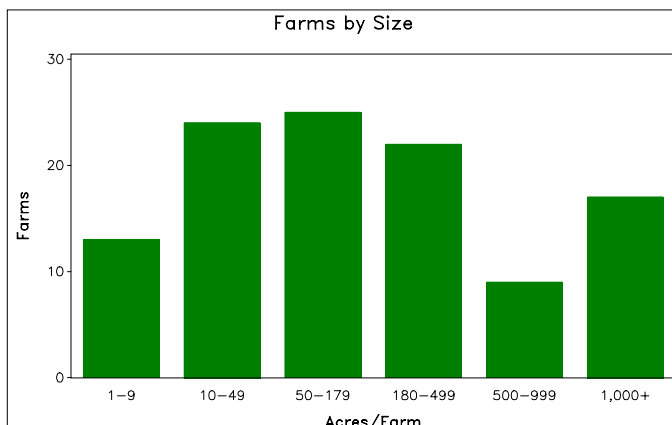
\$67,338 in 2002, \$43,706 in 1997, up 54 percent.
