Farms with Spanish, Hispanic, or Latino Operators Compared with All Farms



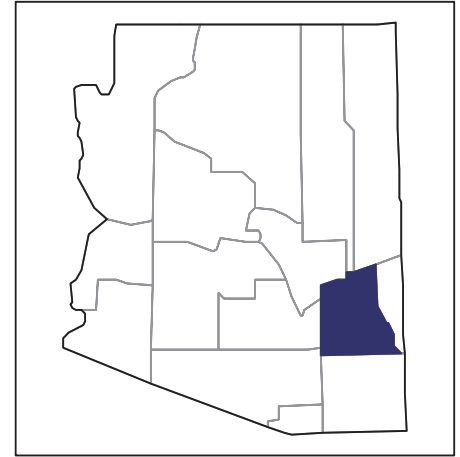

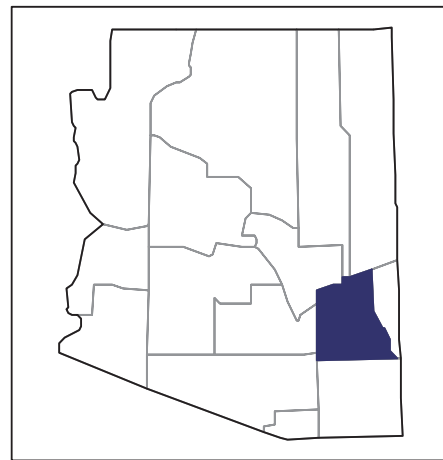

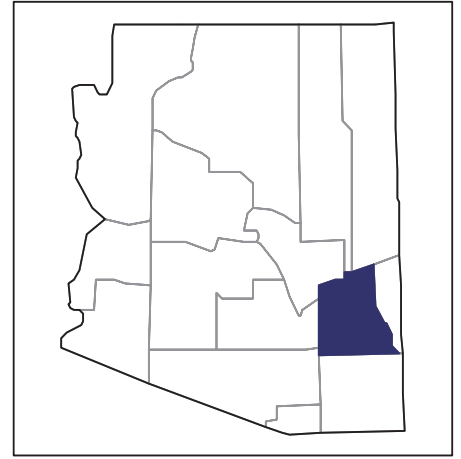

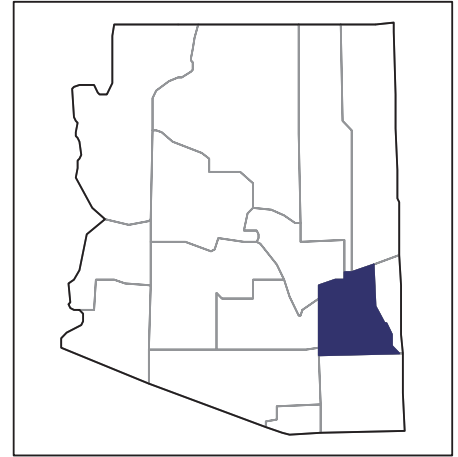

with All Farms



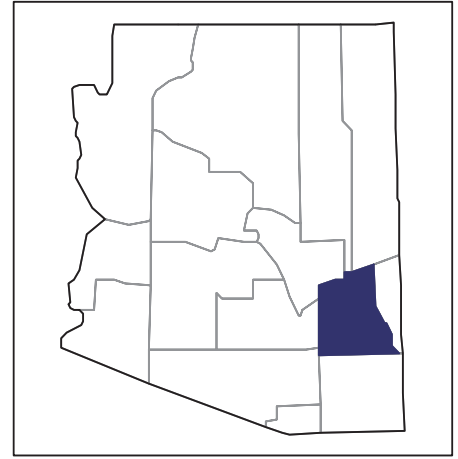

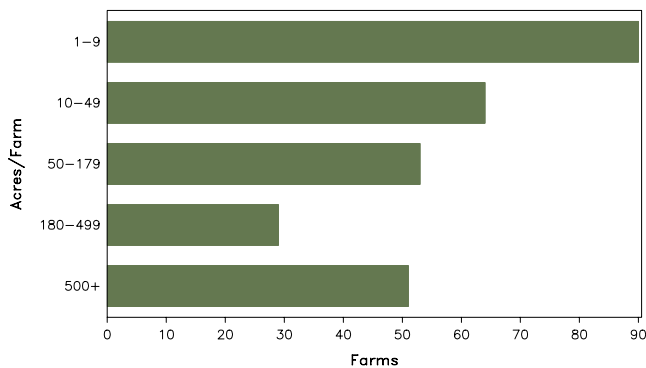

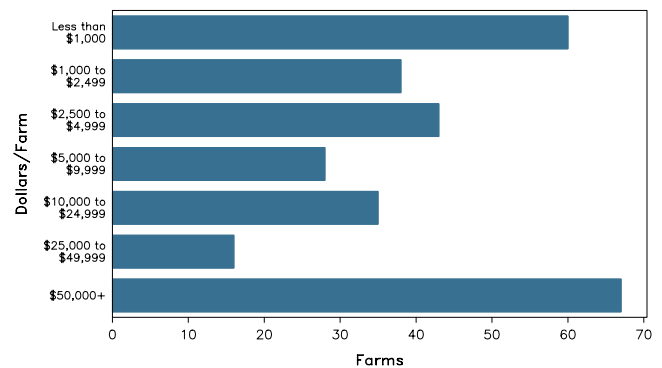
