Farms with American Indian or Alaska Native Operators Compared with All Farms

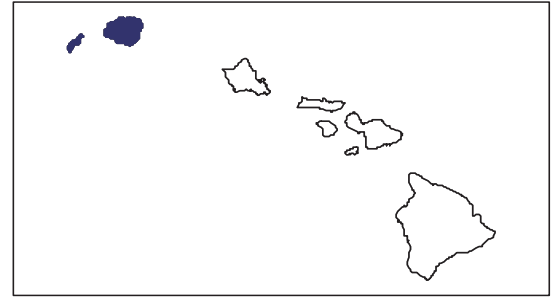

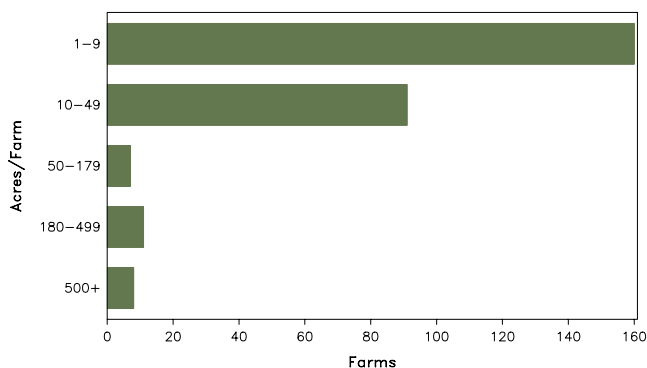

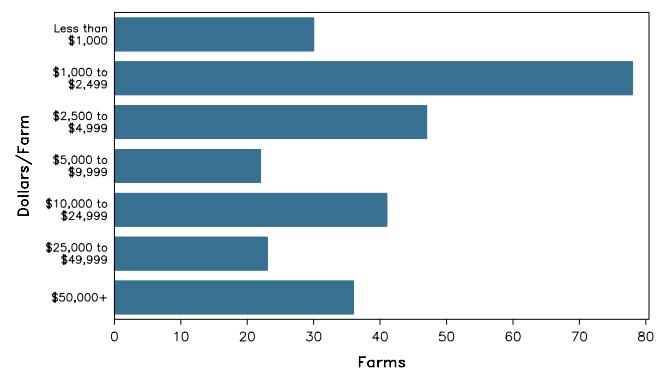

Farms with Black or African American Operators Compared with All Farms

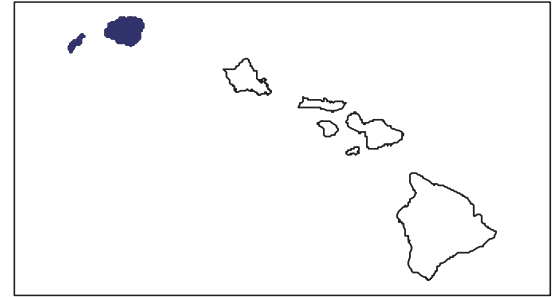
