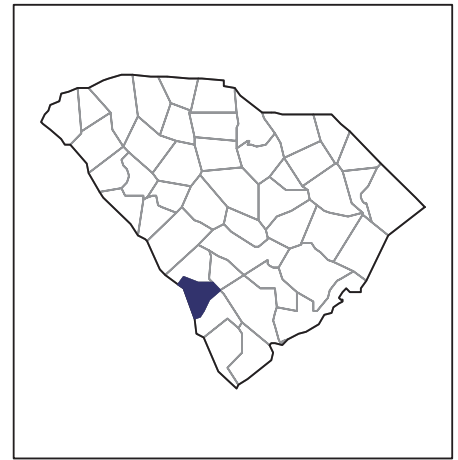

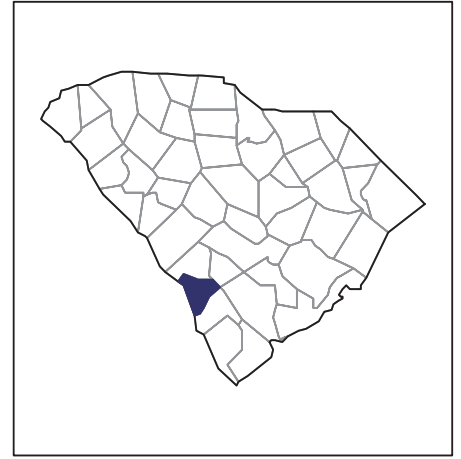

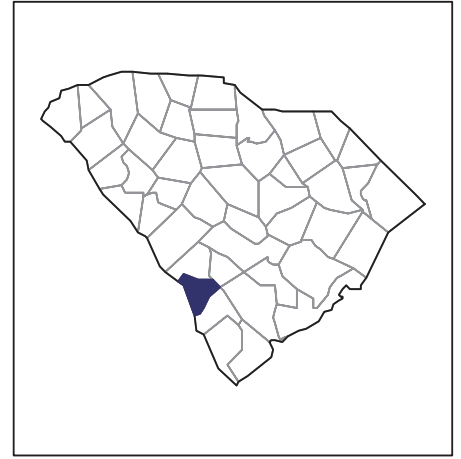

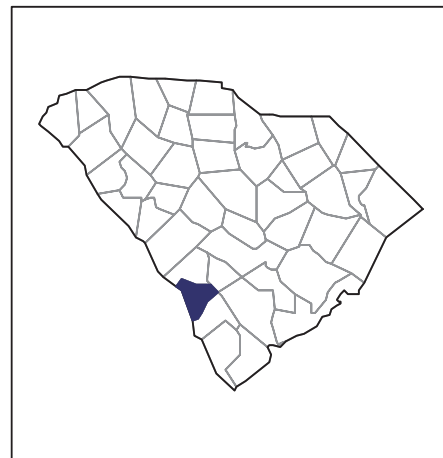

Compared with All Farms



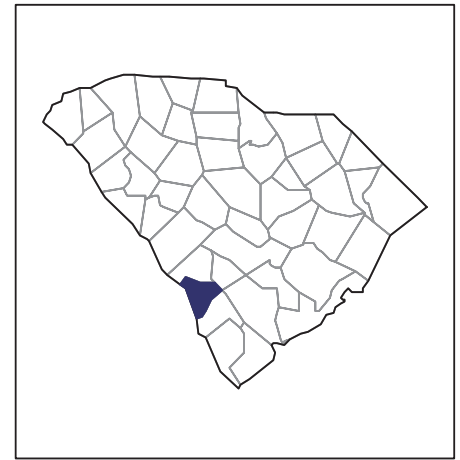

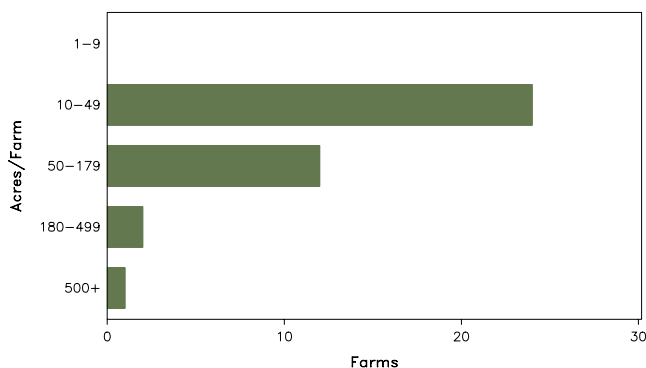

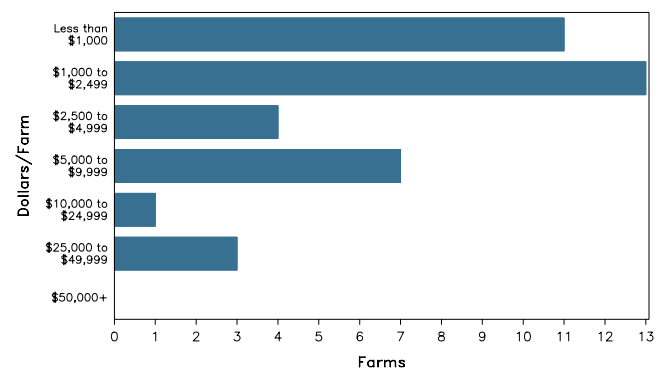

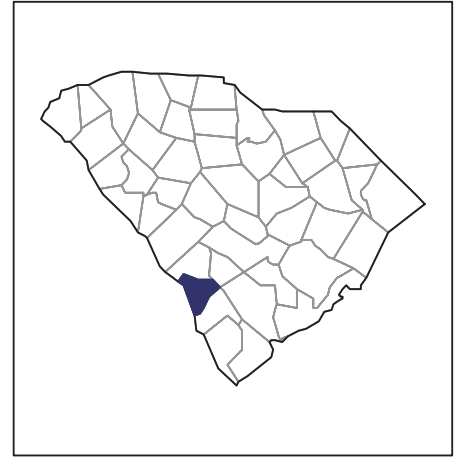

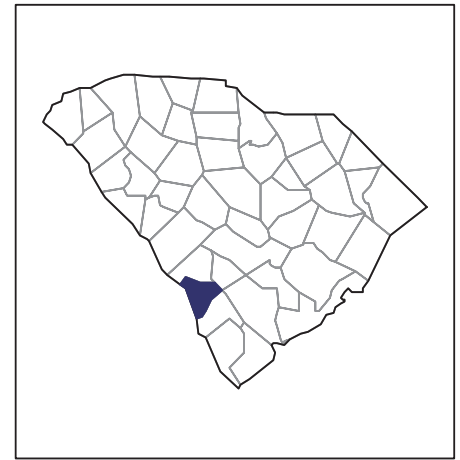

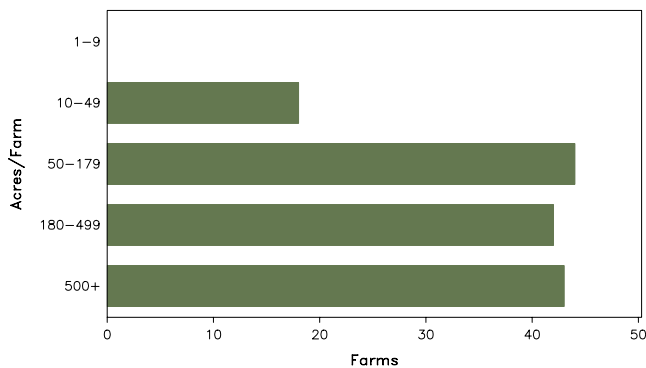

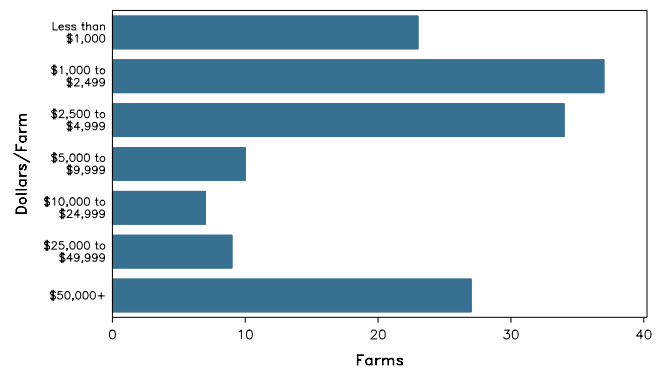
