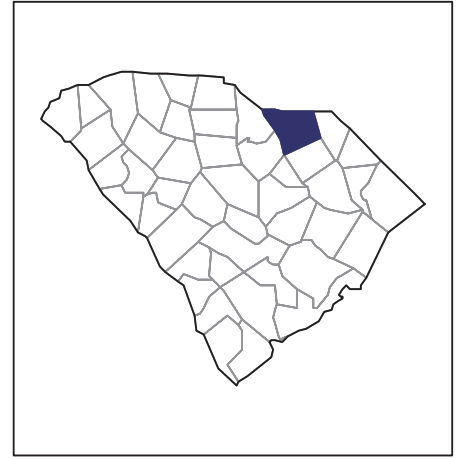

Farms with Women Principal Operators Compared with All Farms

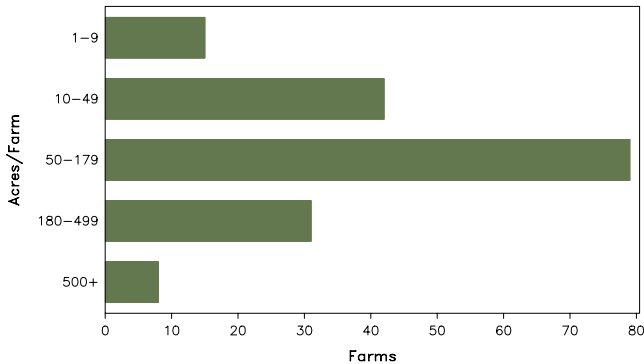

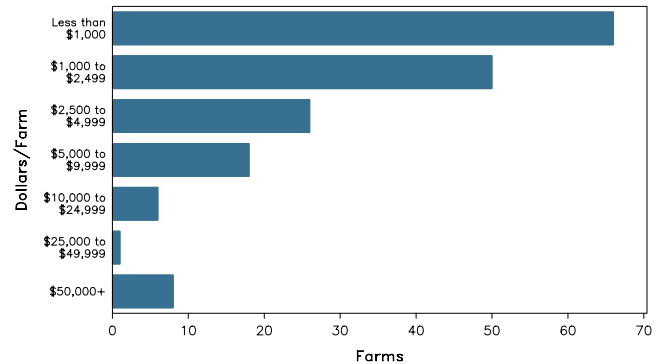

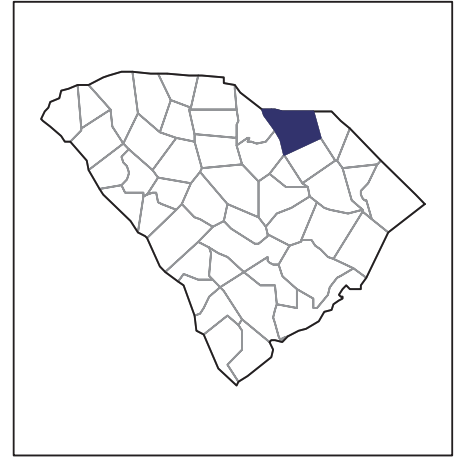

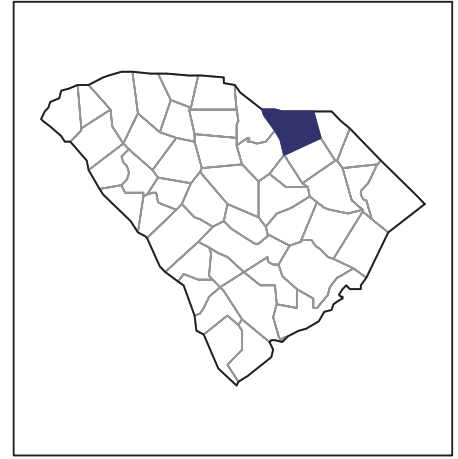

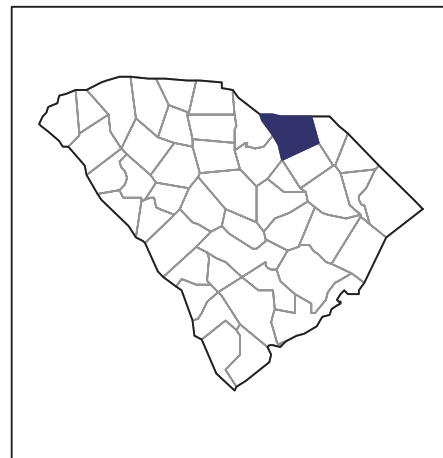

Compared with All Farms**



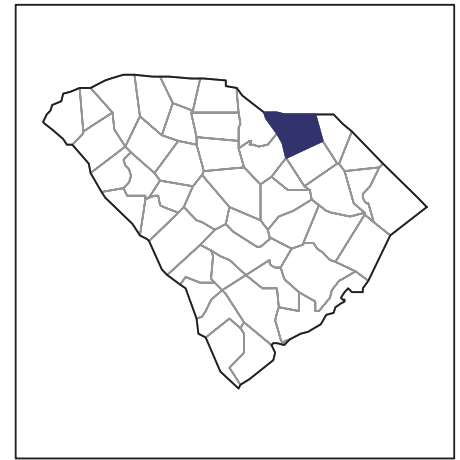

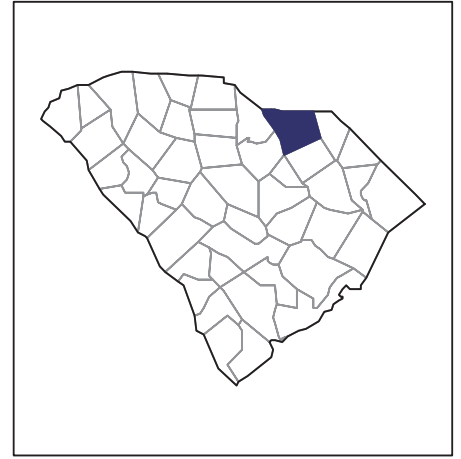

with All Farms**



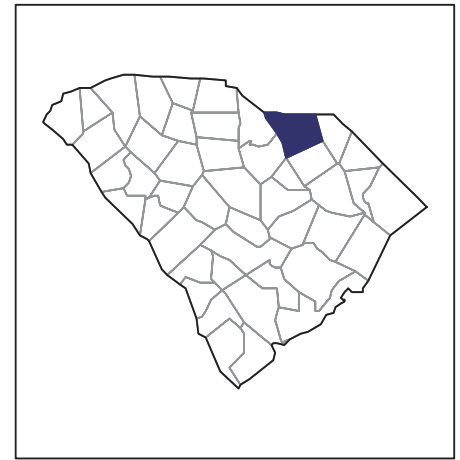

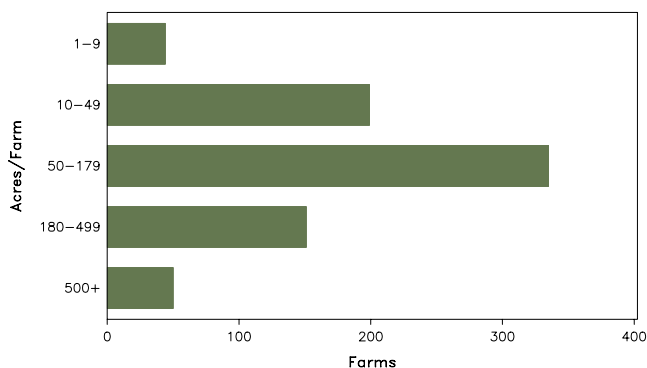

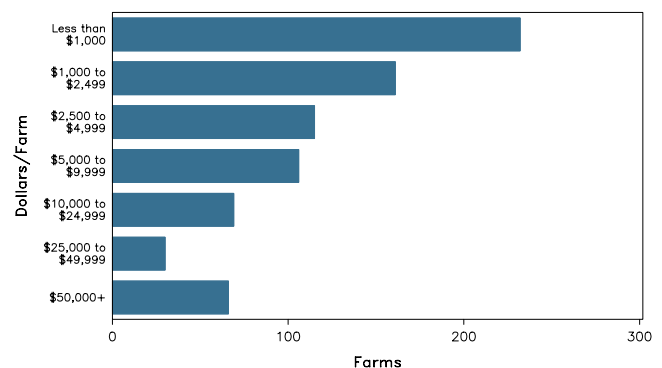
