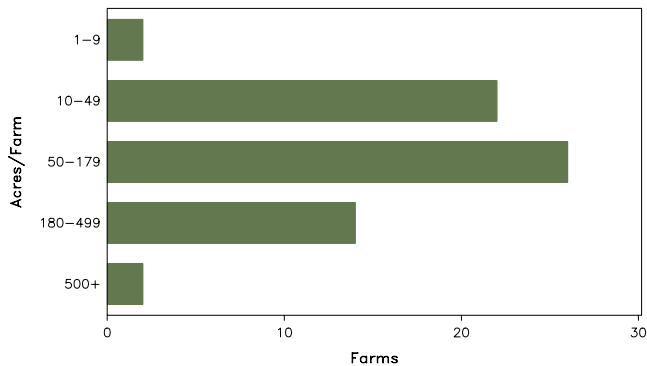

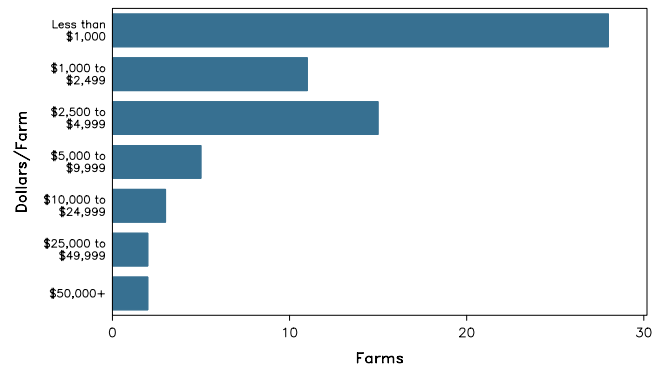

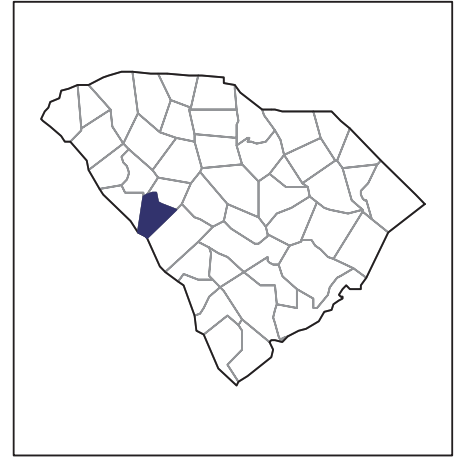

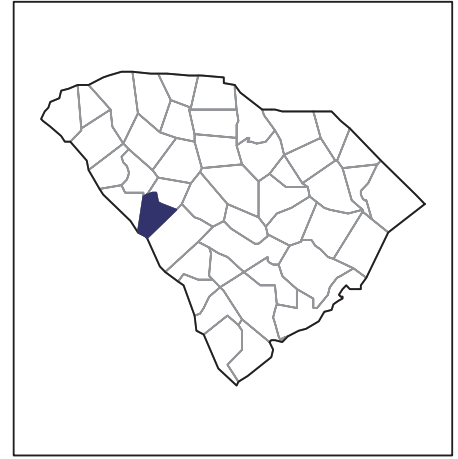

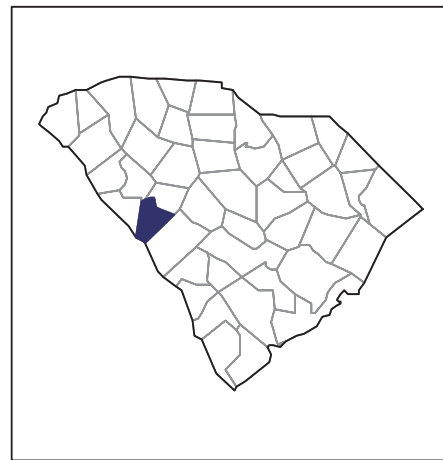

Compared with All Farms



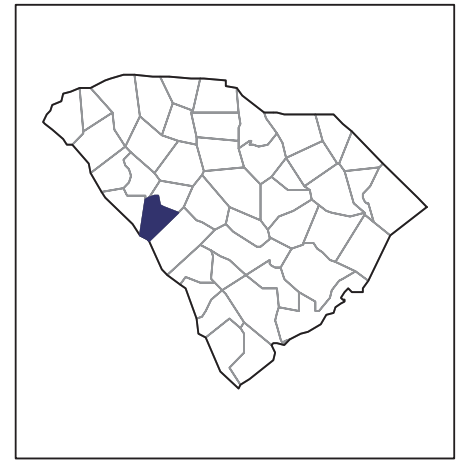

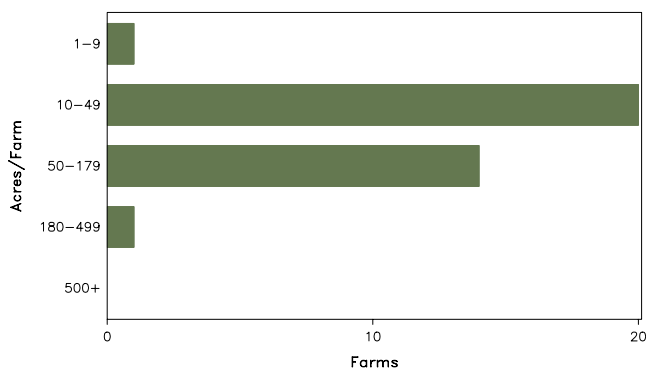

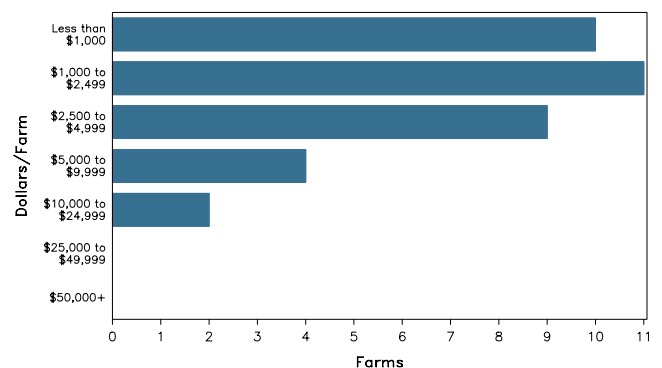

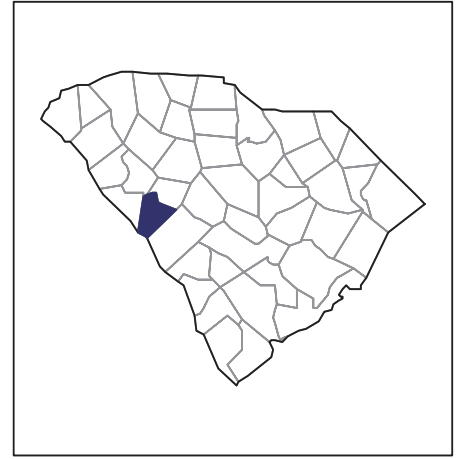

with All Farms



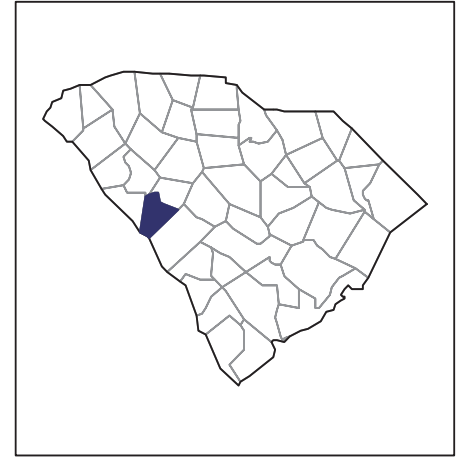

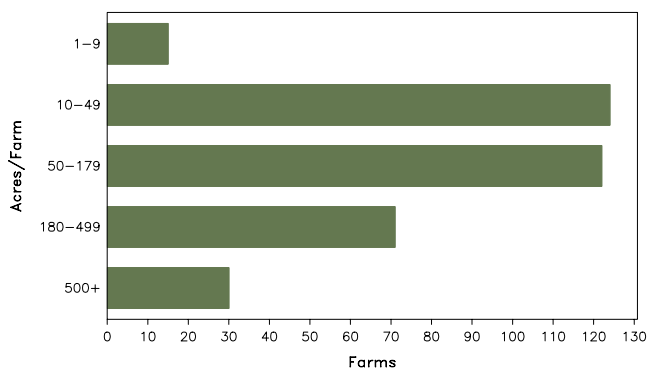

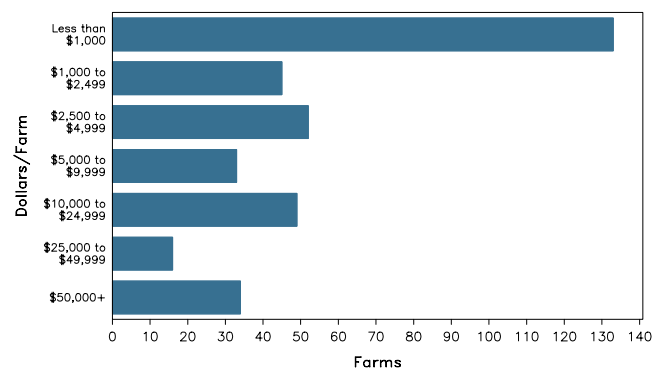
