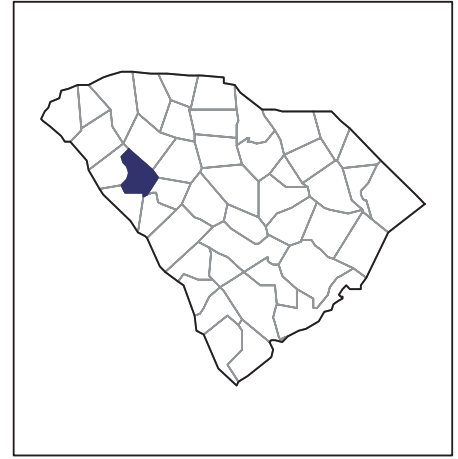

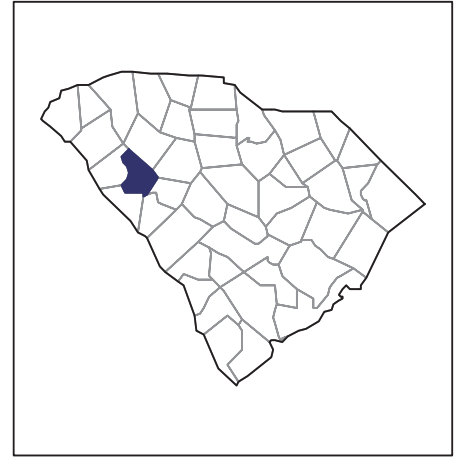

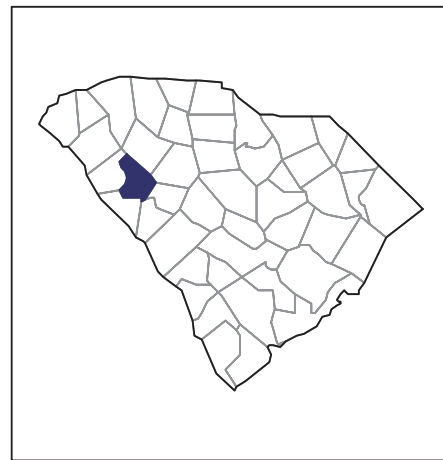

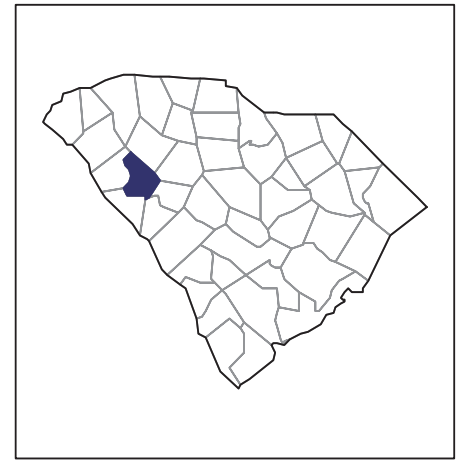

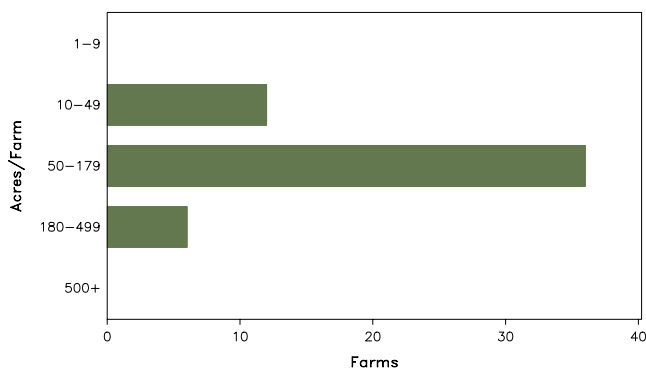

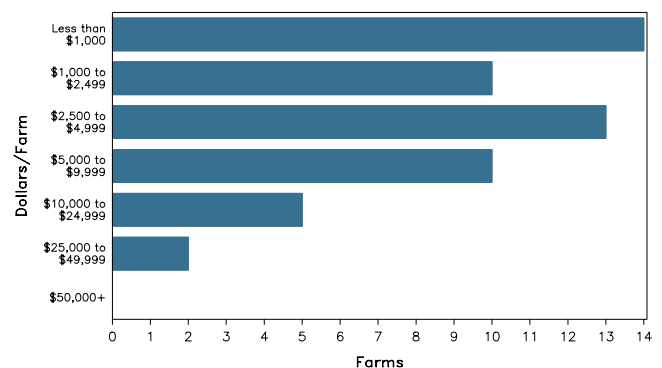

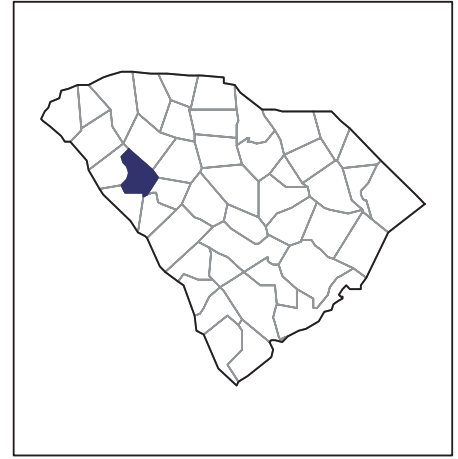

with All Farms**



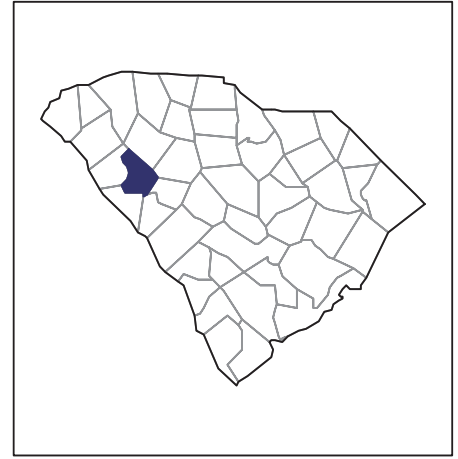

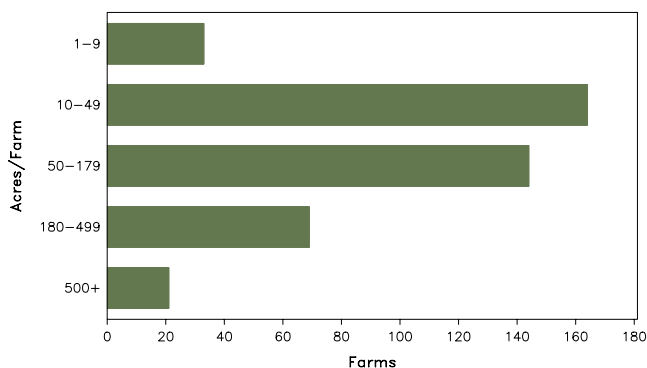

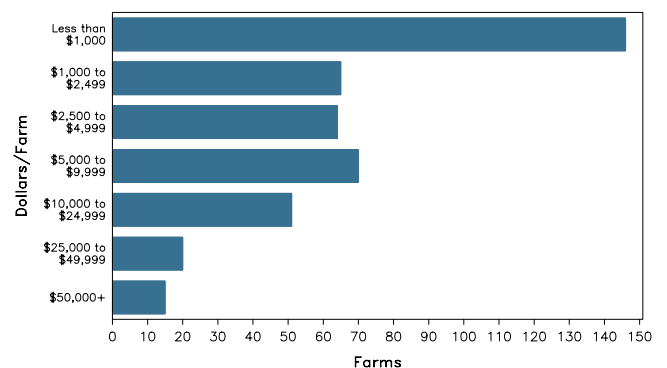
