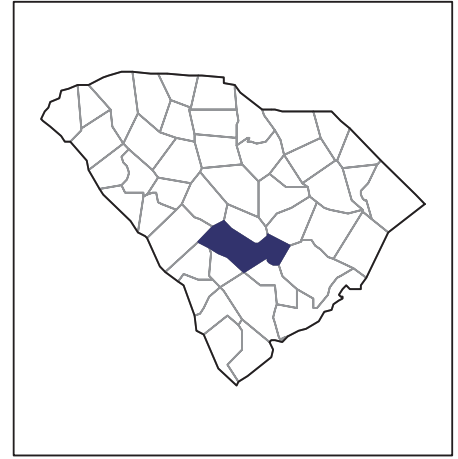

Farms with Women Principal Operators Compared with All Farms

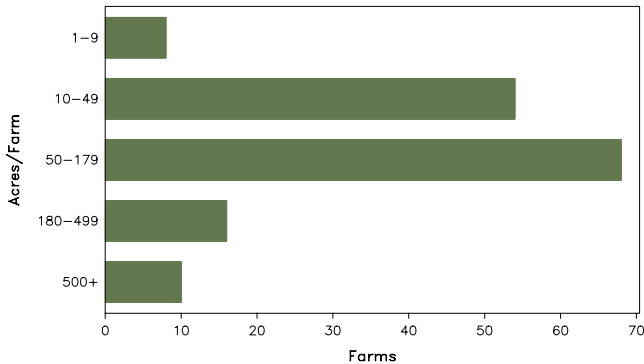

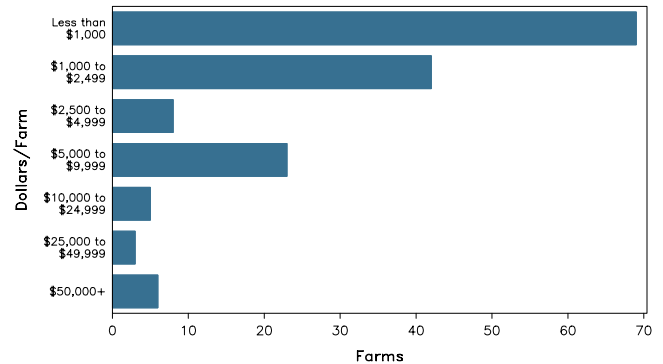

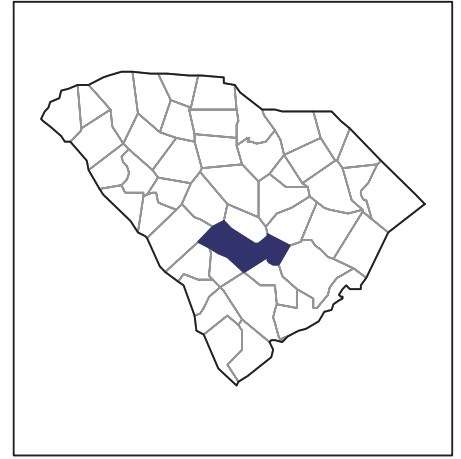

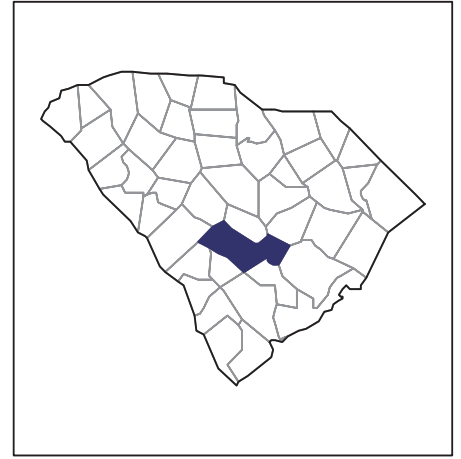

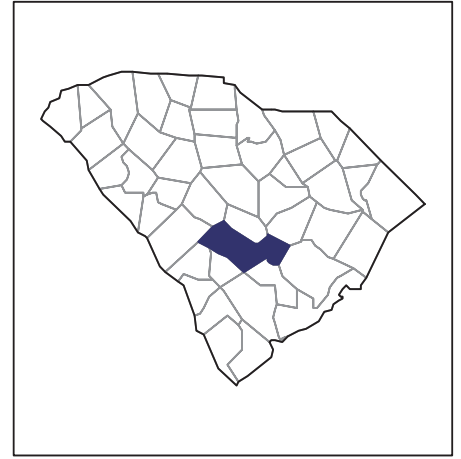

Compared with All Farms**



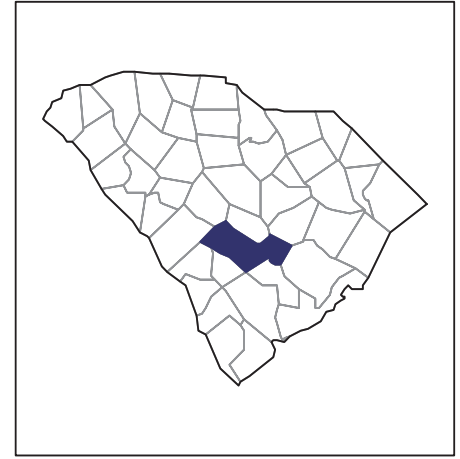

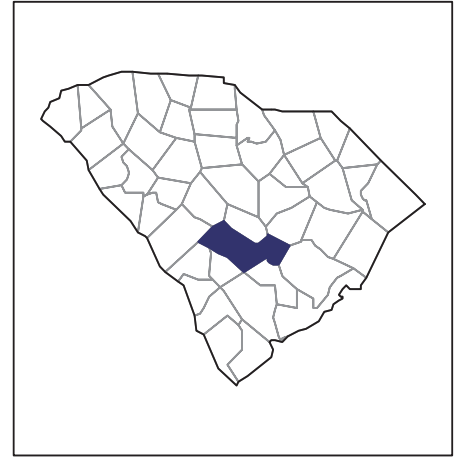

Farms with Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander Operators Compared with All Farms



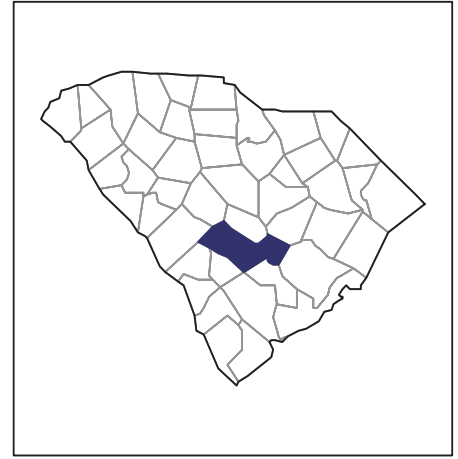

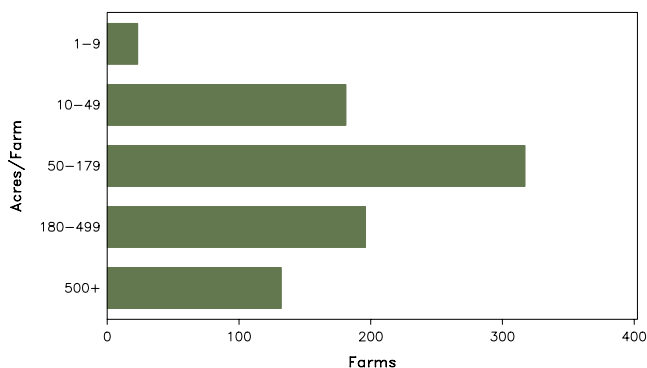

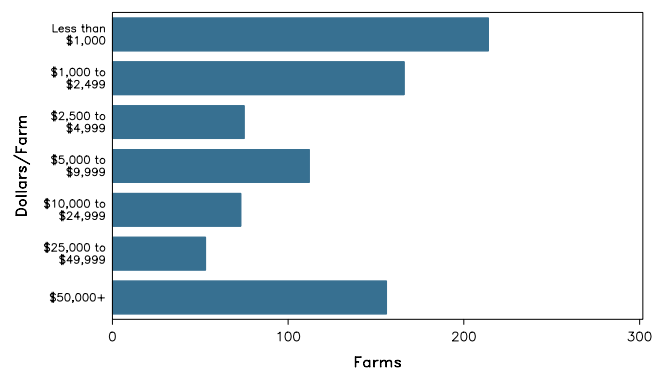
