Farms with Spanish, Hispanic, or Latino Operators Compared with All Farms

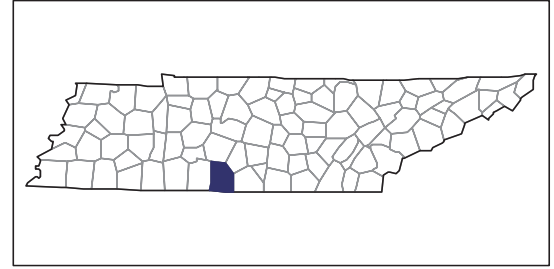

Farms with Asian Operators Compared with All Farms

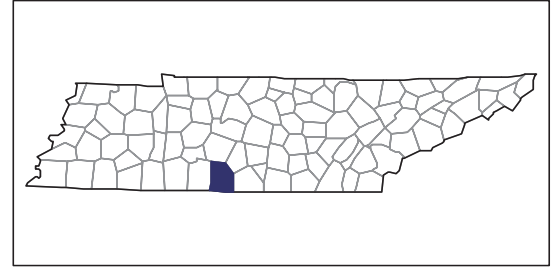

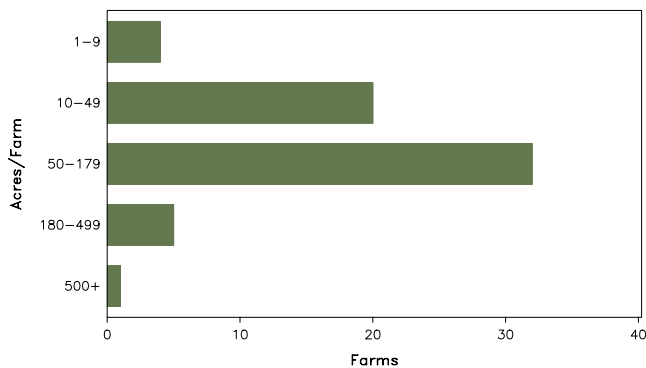

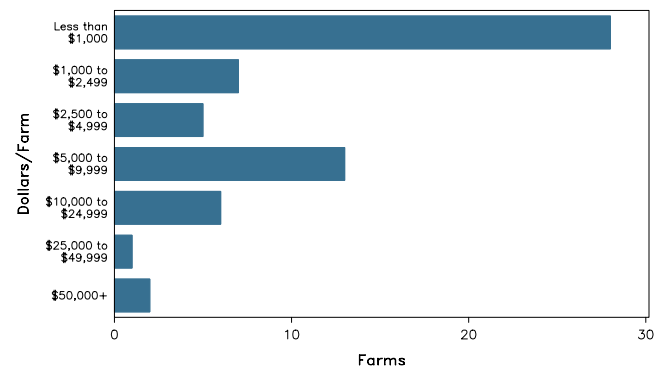

Farms with Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander Operators Compared with All Farms

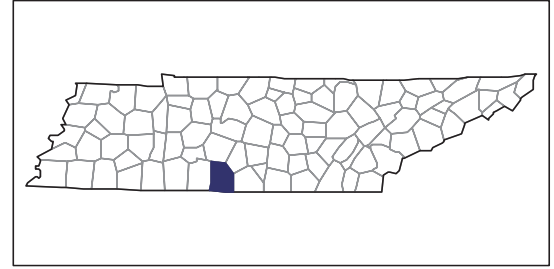

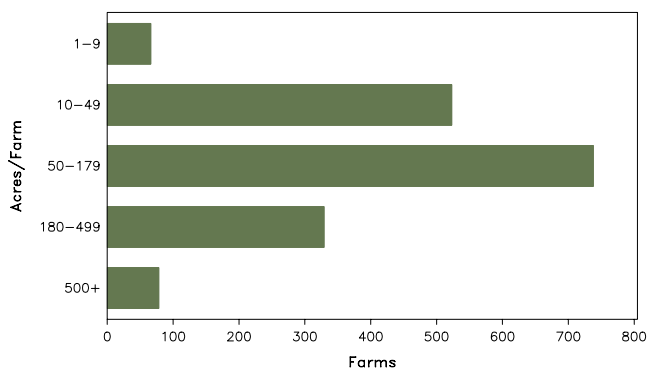

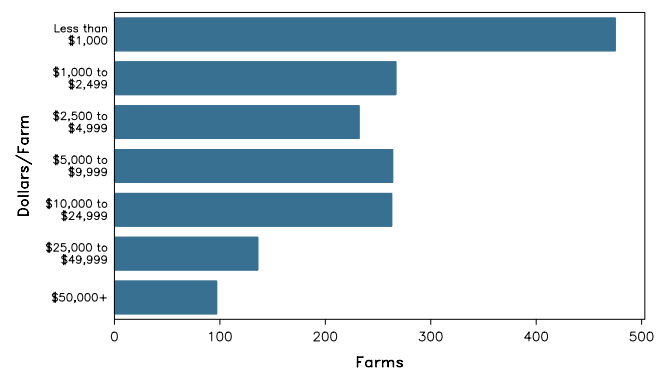
