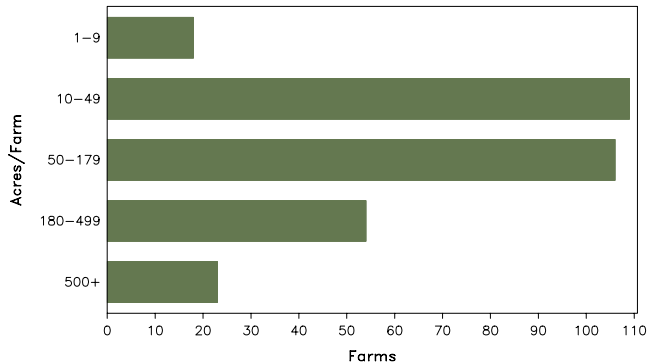

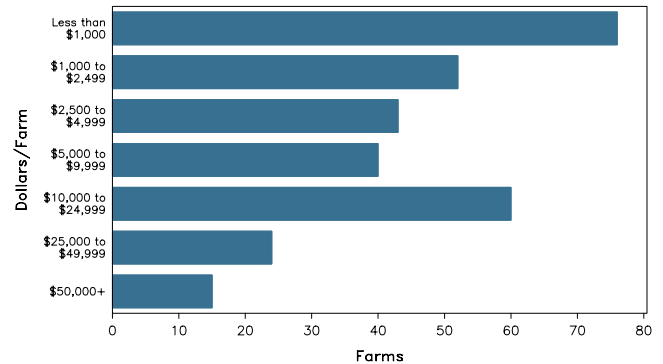

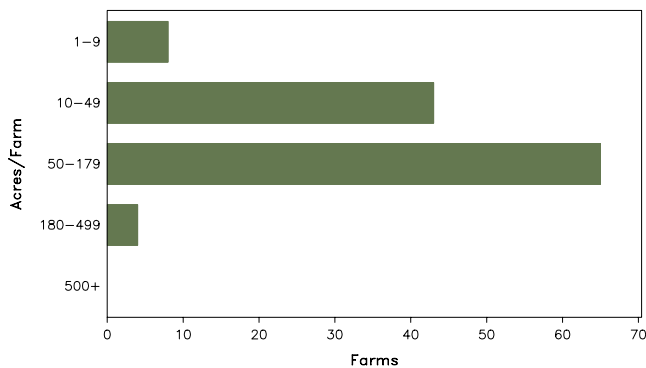

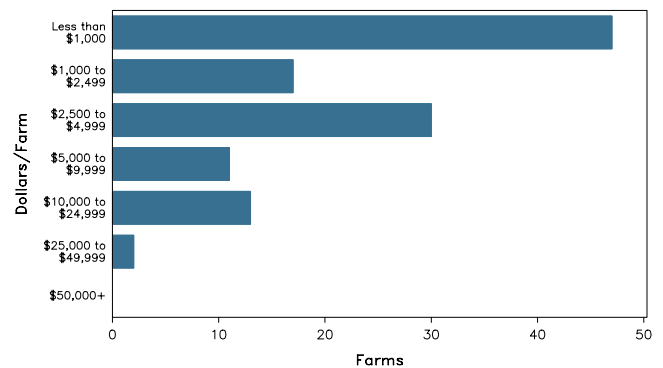
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Farms with Black or African American Operators

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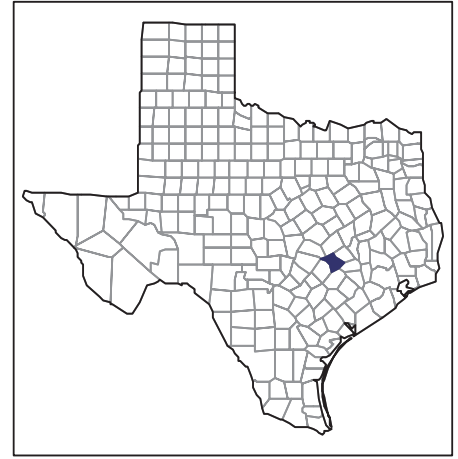

Farms with Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander Operators Compared with All Farms



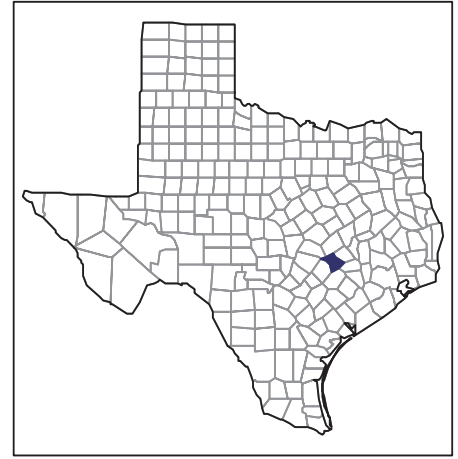

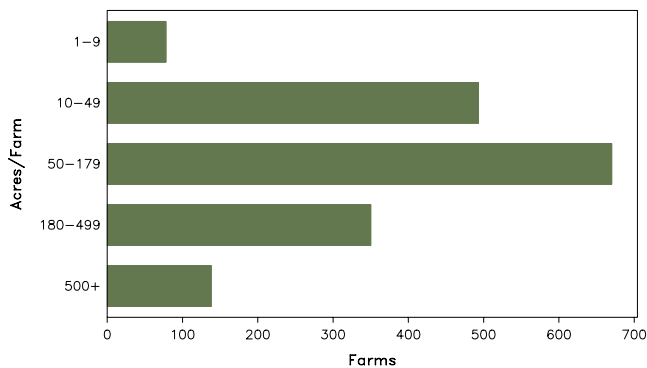

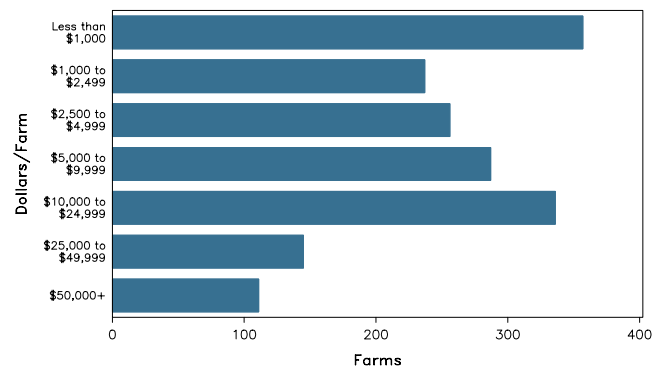
