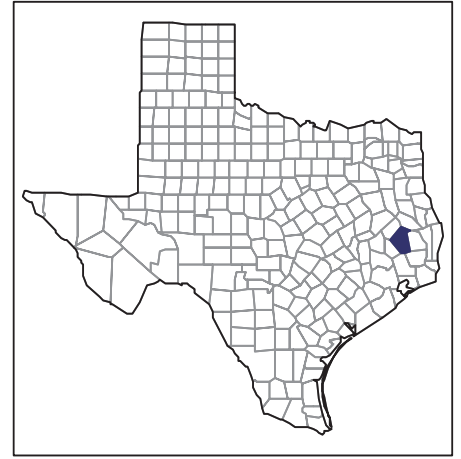

Compared with All Farms**



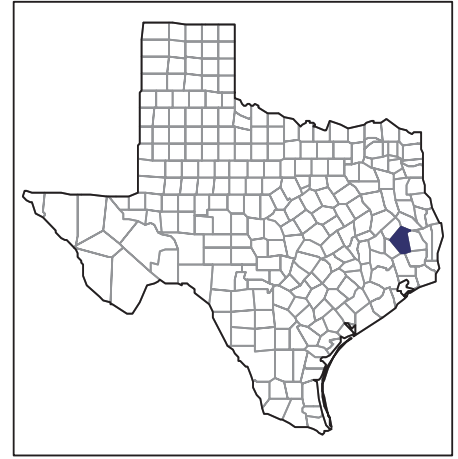

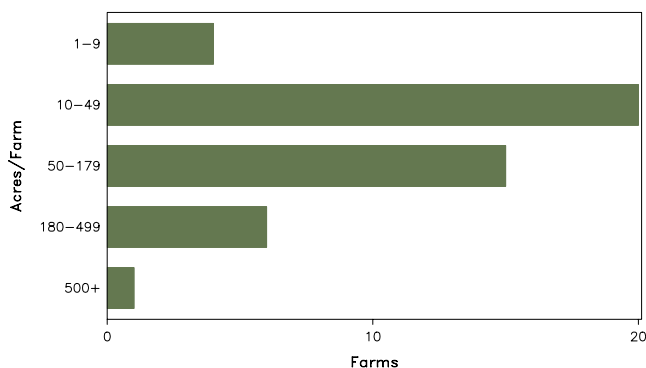

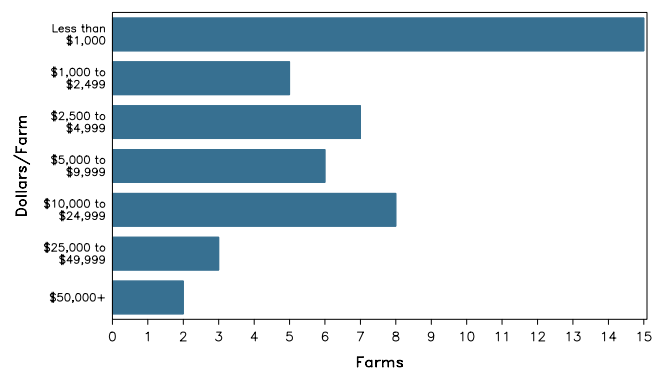

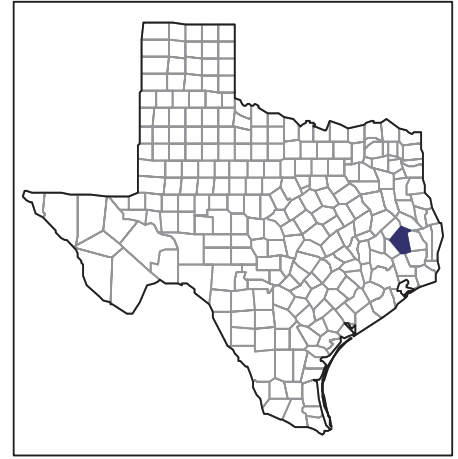

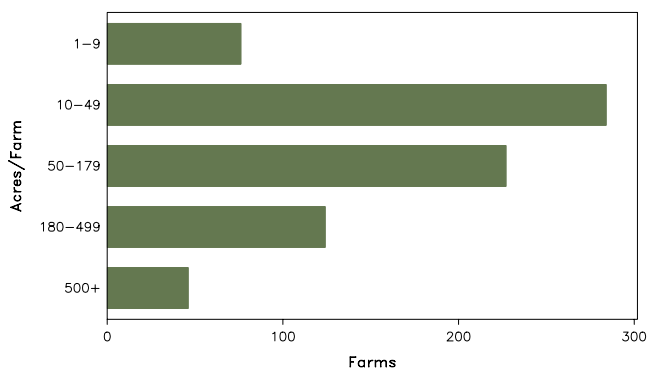

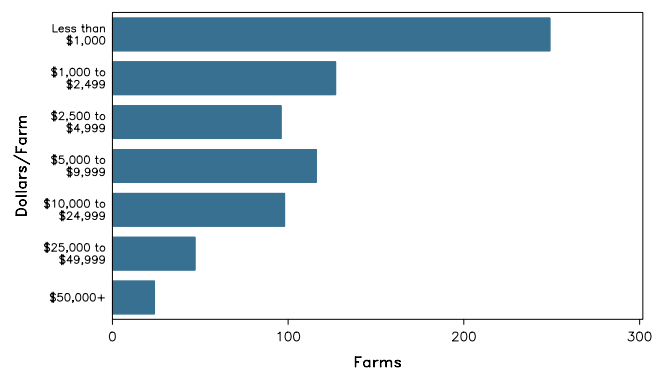
