Farms with Asian Operators Compared with All Farms



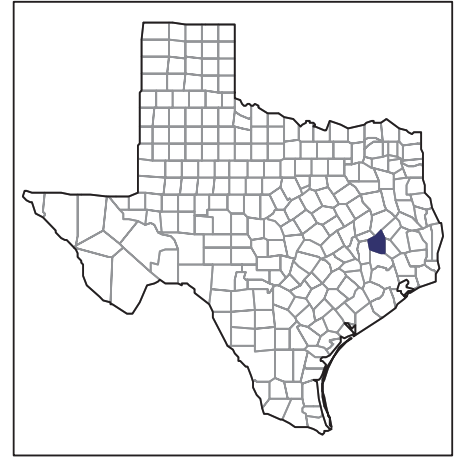

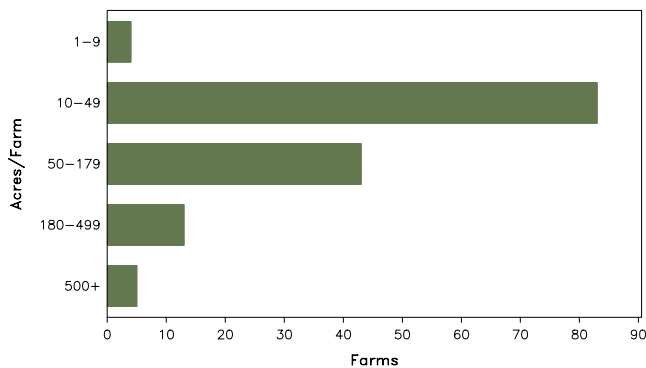

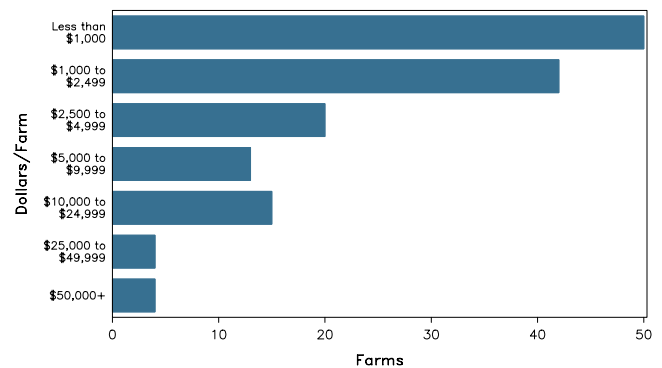

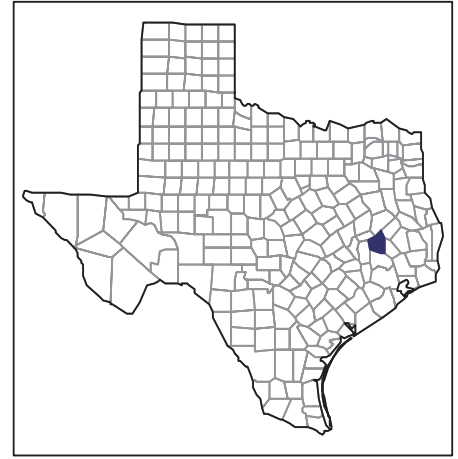

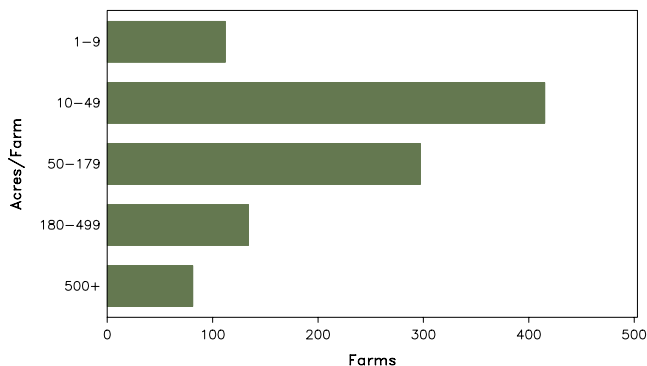

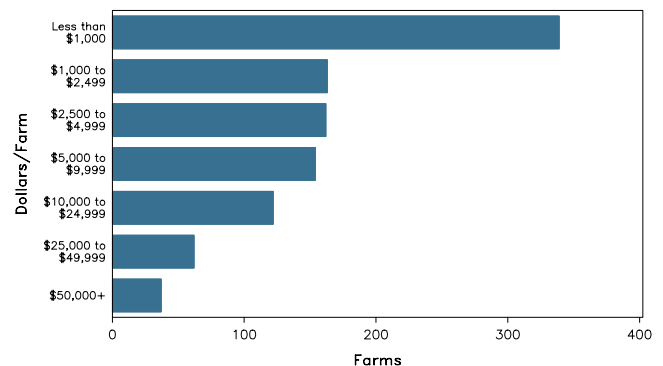
