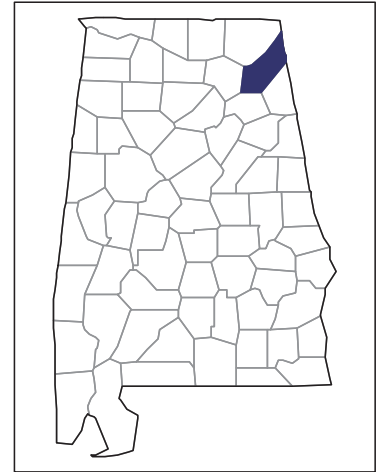
DeKalb County - Alabama

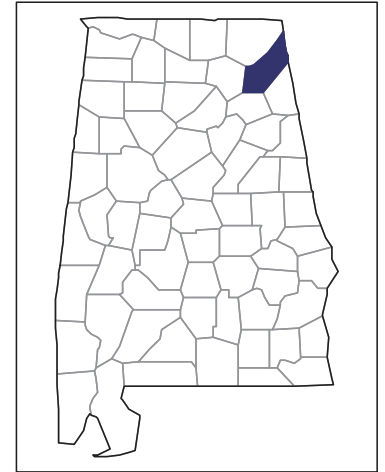
DeKalb County - Alabama
