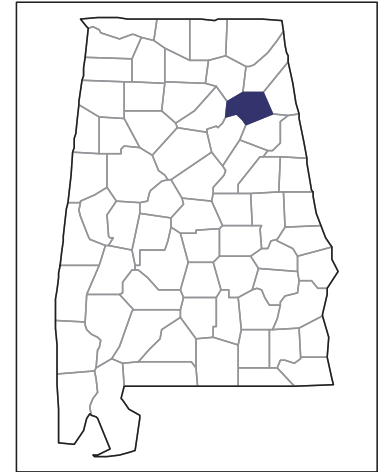

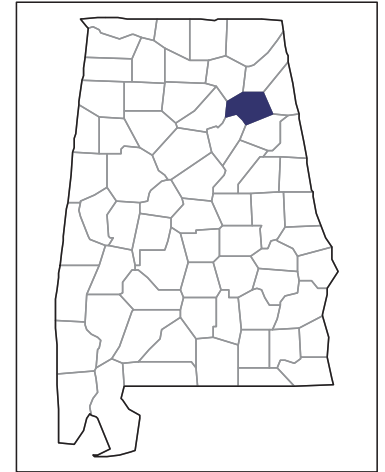

Farms

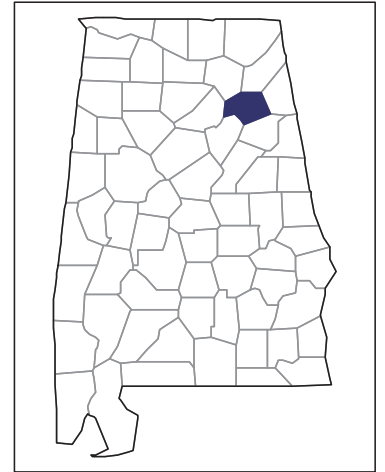

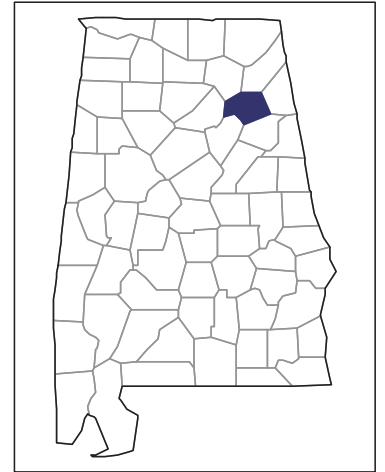

Operators Compared with All Farms

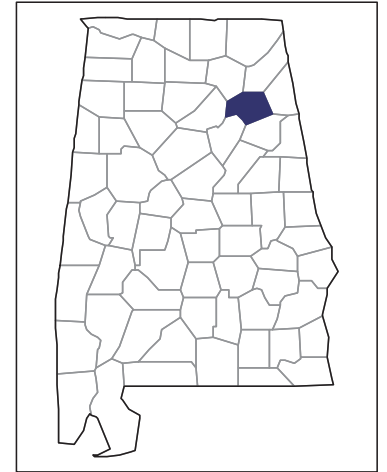

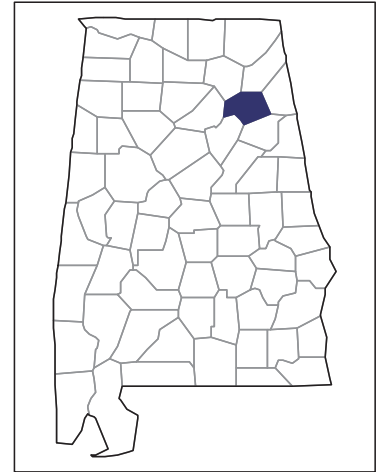
