





Dolores County - Colorado Farms with Spanish, Hispanic, or Latino Operators Compared with All Farms







Dolores County - Colorado Farms with American Indian or Alaska Native Operators Compared with All Farms







# Dolores County - Colorado Farms with Asian Operators Compared with All Farms







### Dolores County - Colorado Farms with Black or African American Operators Compared with All Farms







Dolores County - Colorado Farms with Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander Operators Compared with All Farms
