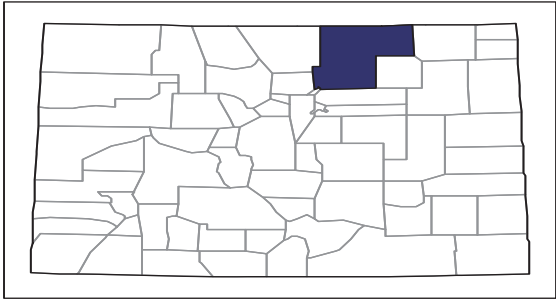

Weld County - Colorado Farms with Black or African American Operators Compared with All Farms

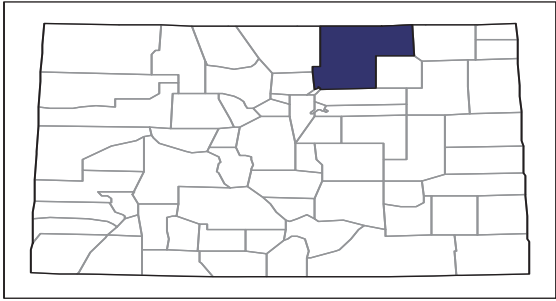

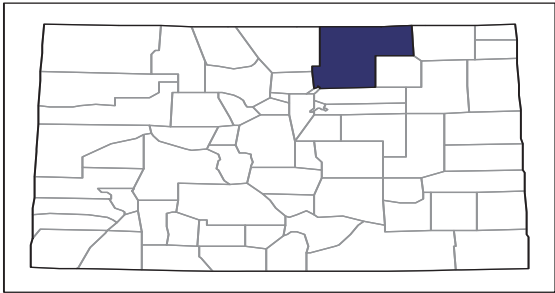
Weld County - Colorado Farms with Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander Operators Compared with All Farms

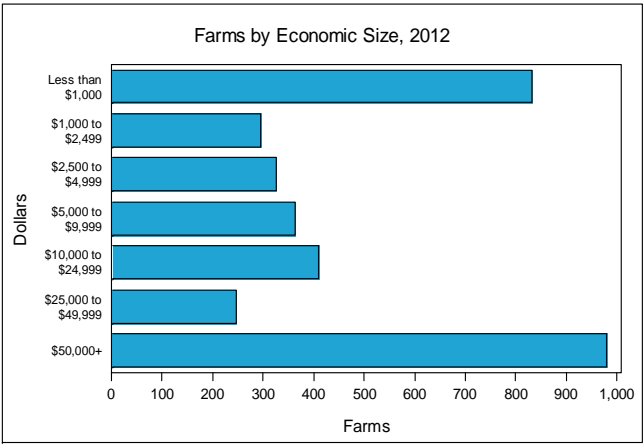
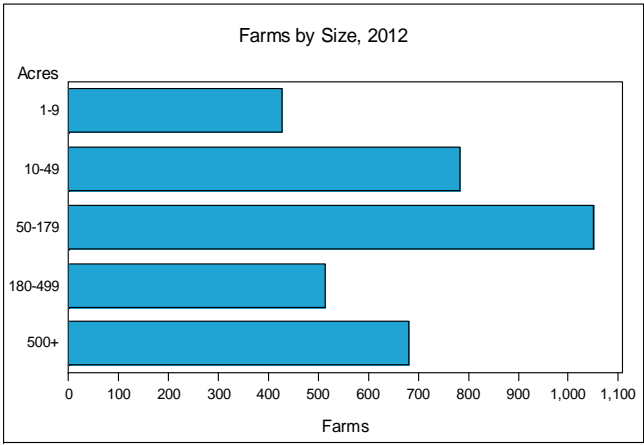



