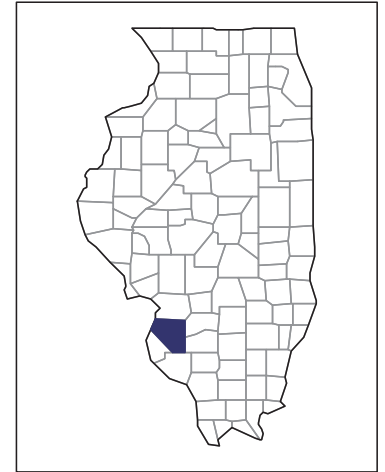

Farms

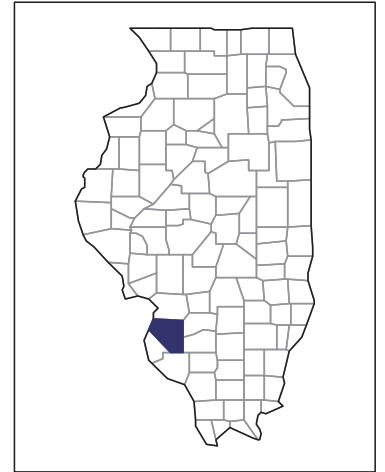

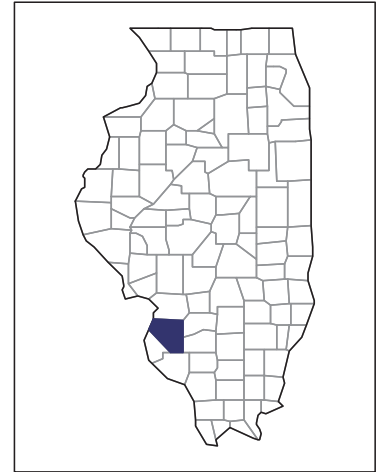
St. Clair County - Illinois

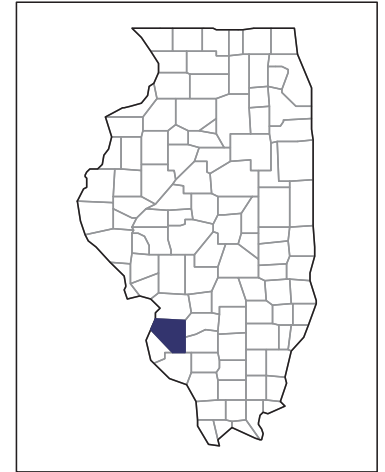

Farms with Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander Operators Compared with All Farms

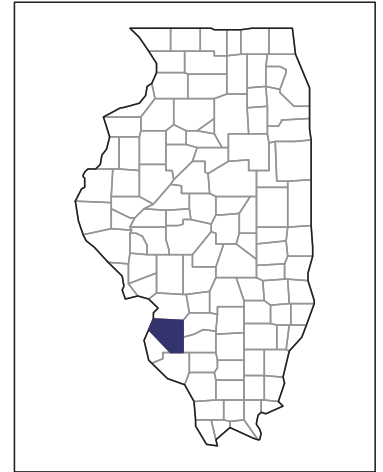
