


Plymouth County - Massachusetts Farms with American Indian or Alaska Native Operators Compared with All Farms





Plymouth County - Massachusetts Farms with Asian Operators Compared with All Farms







## Plymouth County - Massachusetts Farms with Black or African American Operators Compared with All Farms


Plymouth County - Massachusetts Farms with Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander Operators Compared with All Farms
