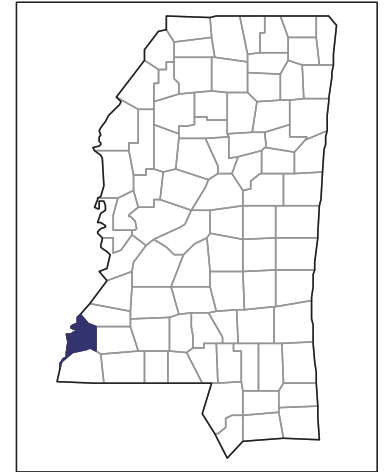

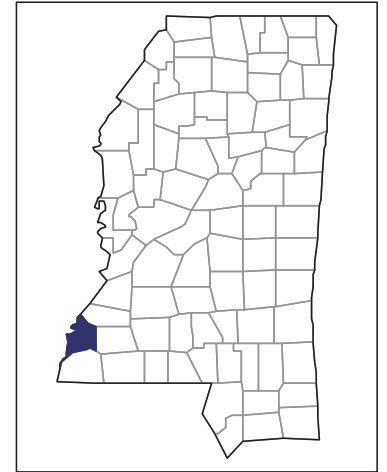

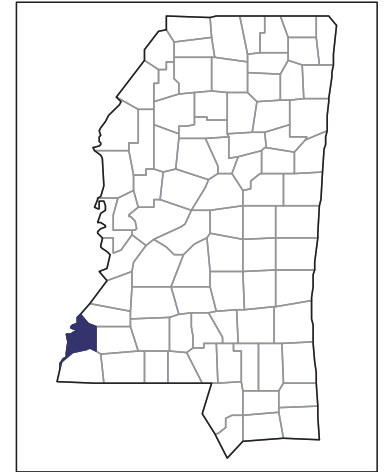

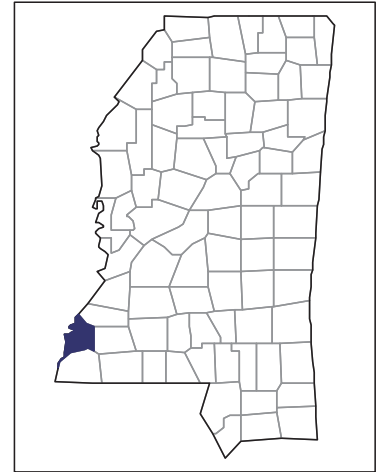

with All Farms**



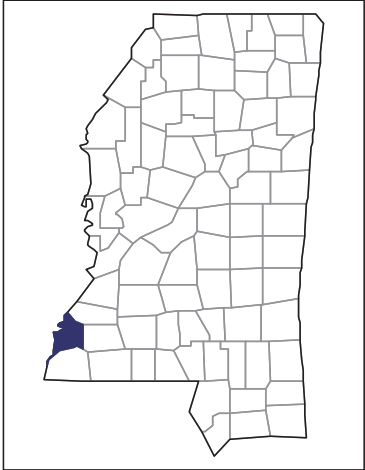
