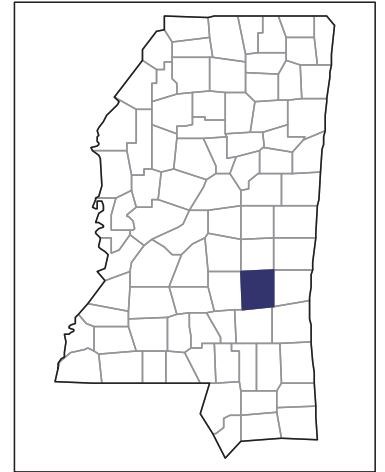

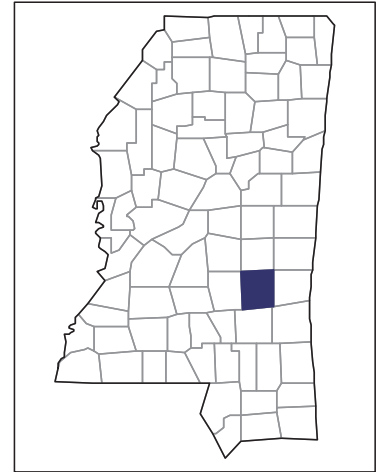

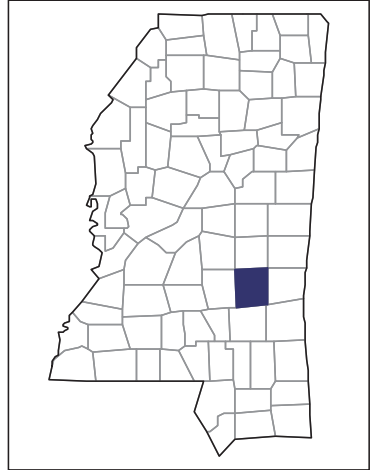
**Jasper County - Mississippi

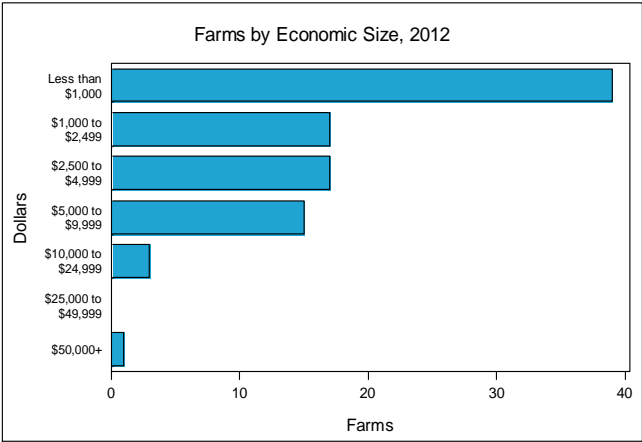

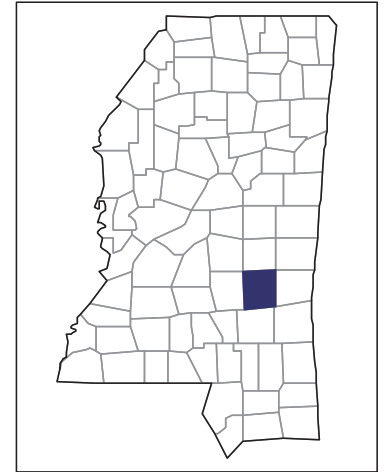
