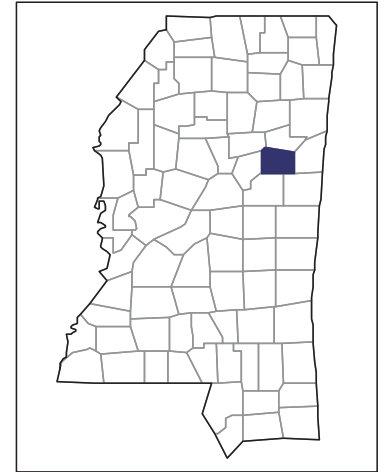

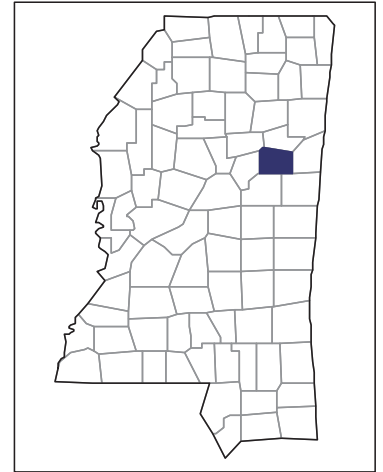

with All Farms

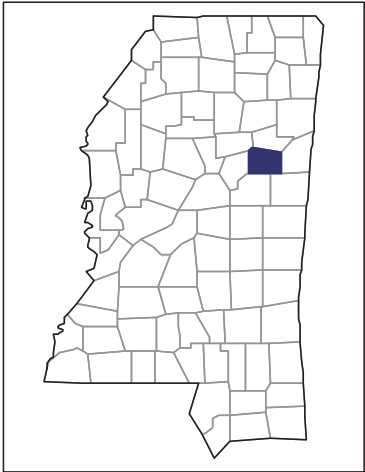

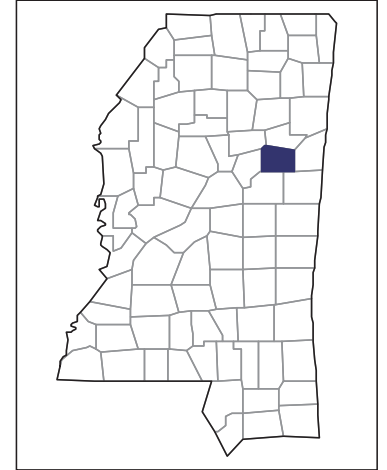
