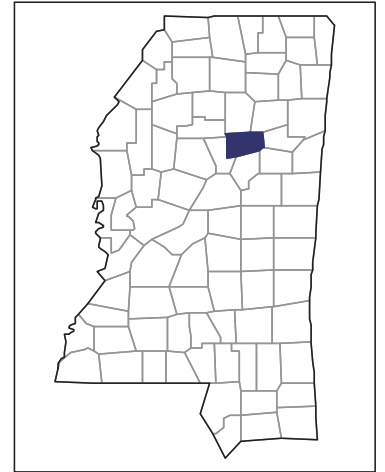

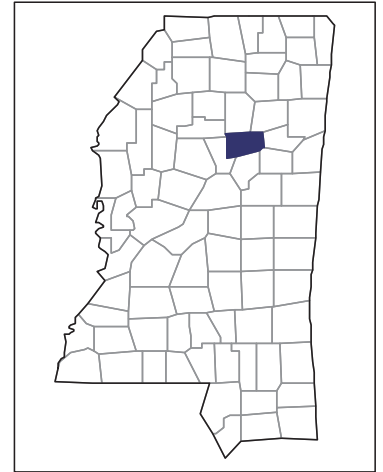

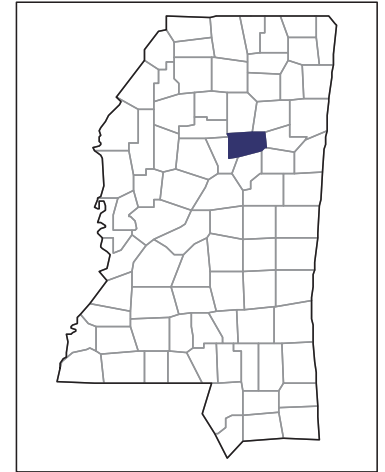
Webster County - Mississippi

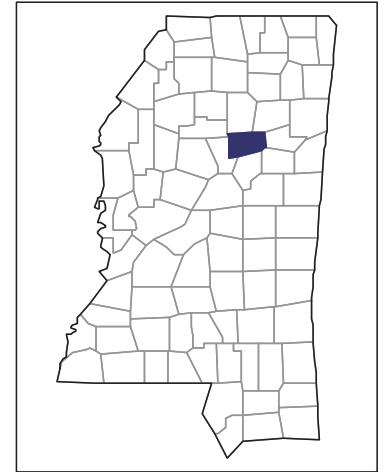

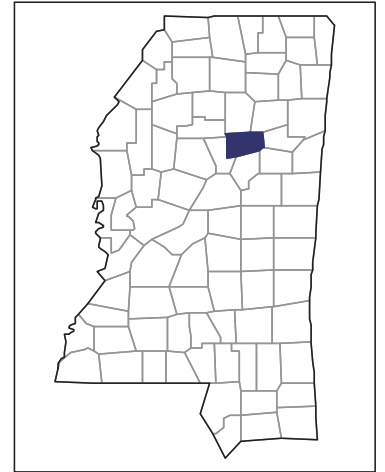
