McDonald County - Missouri Farms with Spanish, Hispanic, or Latino Operators Compared with All Farms

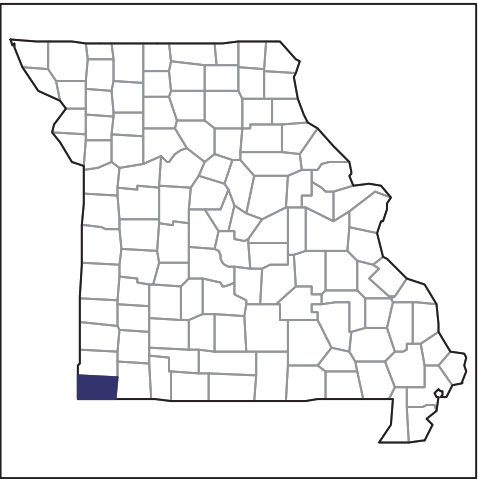

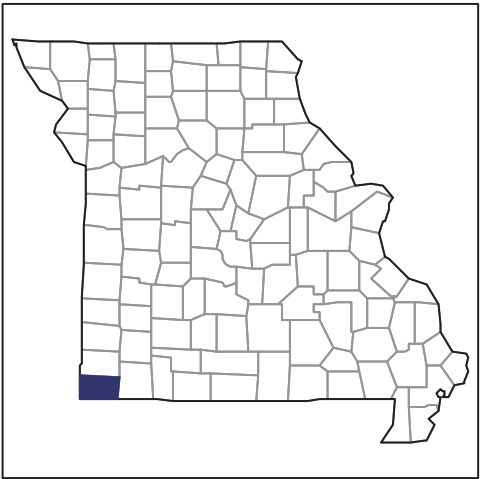

McDonald County - Missouri Farms with Black or African American Operators Compared with All Farms



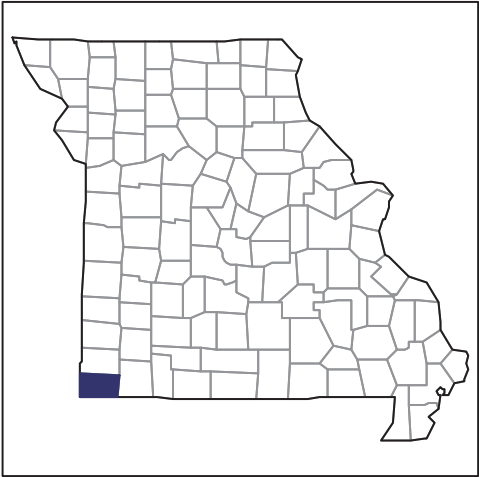

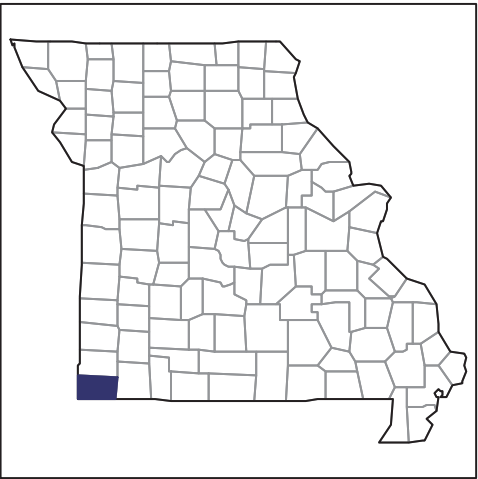
McDonald County - Missouri Farms with Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander Operators Compared with All Farms

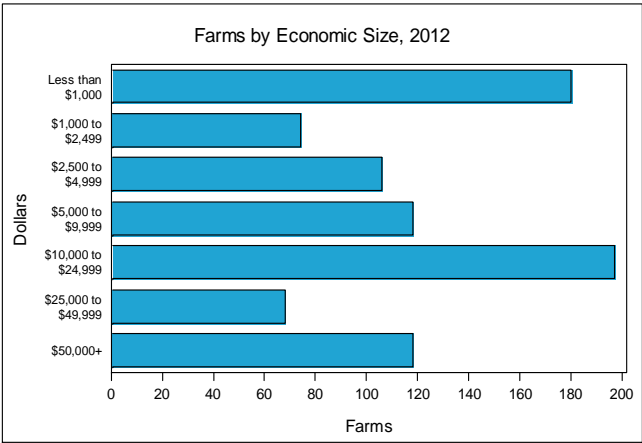
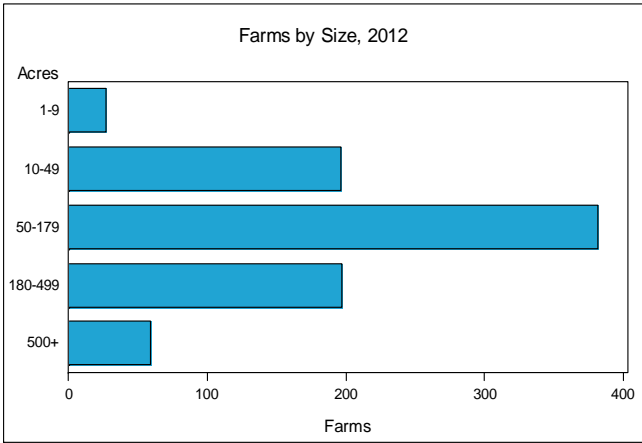
