






Broadwater County - Montana Farms with Spanish, Hispanic, or Latino Operators Compared with All Farms






Broadwater County - Montana Farms with American Indian or Alaska Native Operators Compared with All Farms






## Broadwater County - Montana Farms with Asian Operators Compared with All Farms








Broadwater County - Montana Farms with Black or African American Operators Compared with All Farms








Broadwater County - Montana Farms with Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander Operators Compared with All Farms
