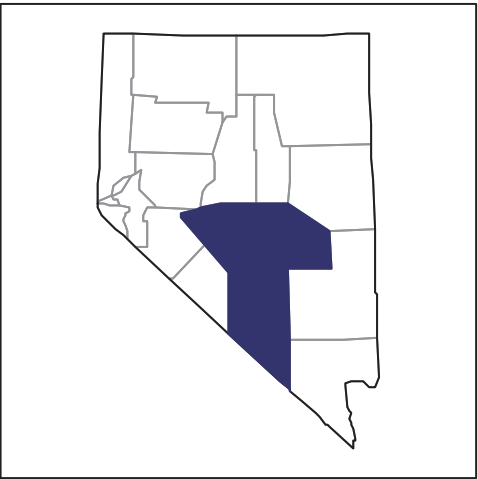
Nye County - Nevada Farms with Spanish, Hispanic, or Latino Operators Compared with All Farms

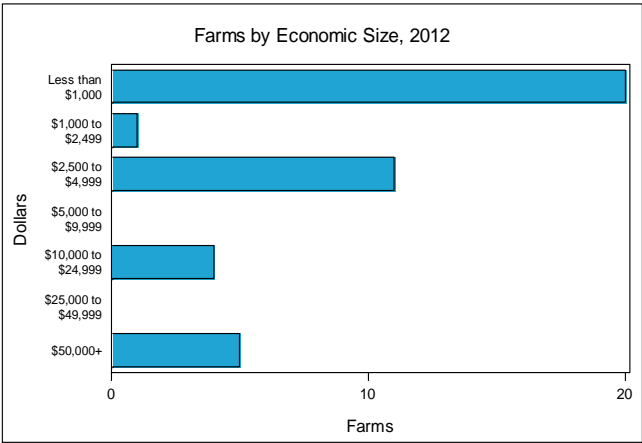
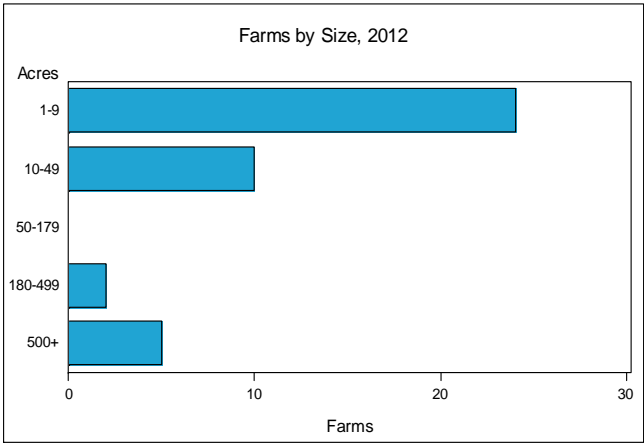

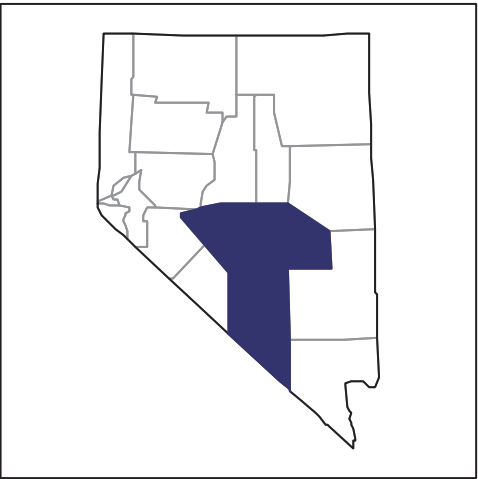

Nye County - Nevada Farms with Asian Operators Compared with All Farms



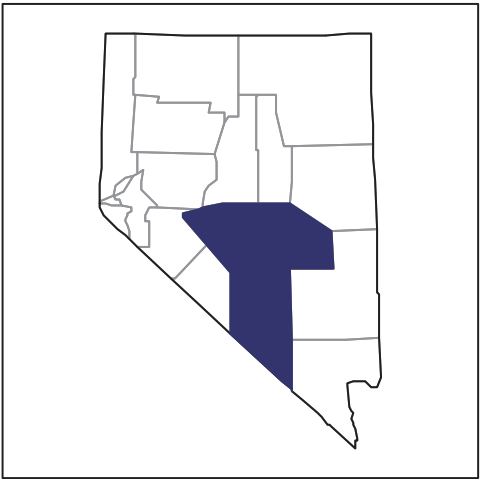

Nye County - Nevada Farms with Black or African American Operators Compared with All Farms



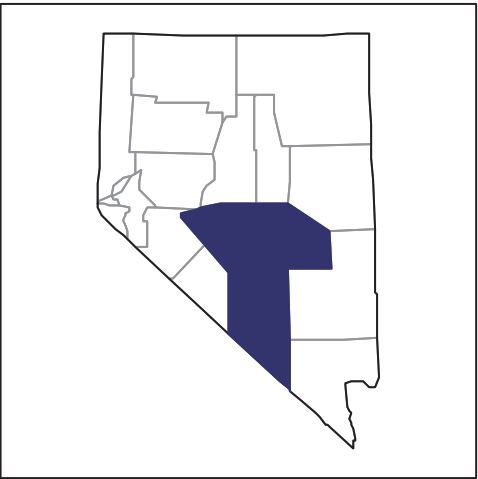

Nye County - Nevada Farms with Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander Operators Compared with All Farms

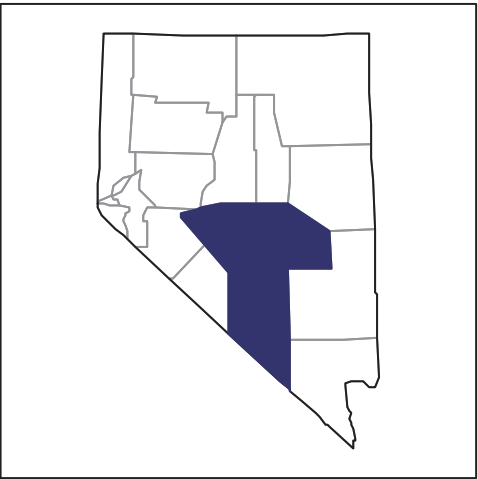

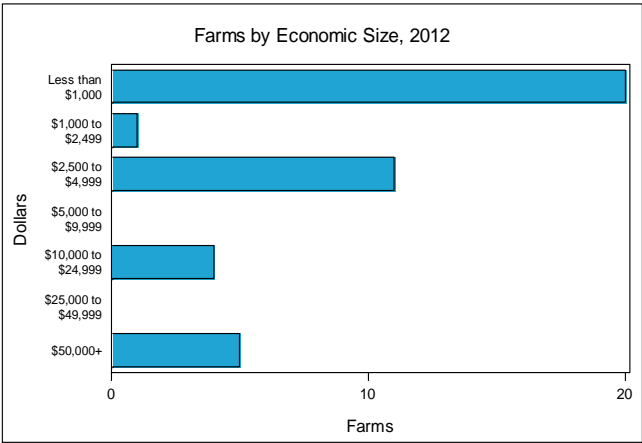
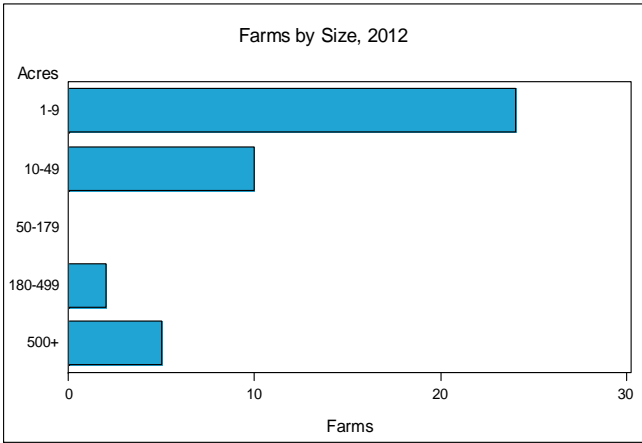
