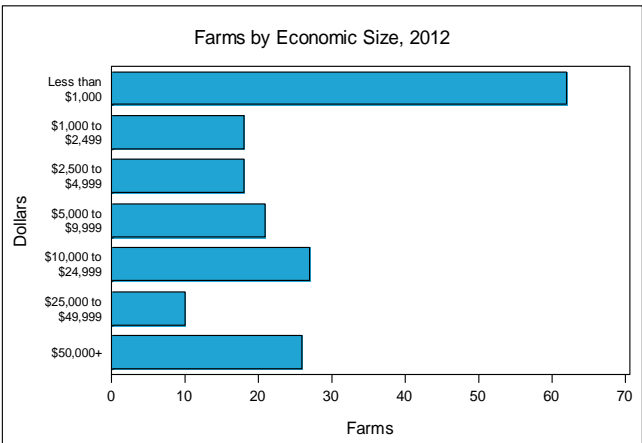
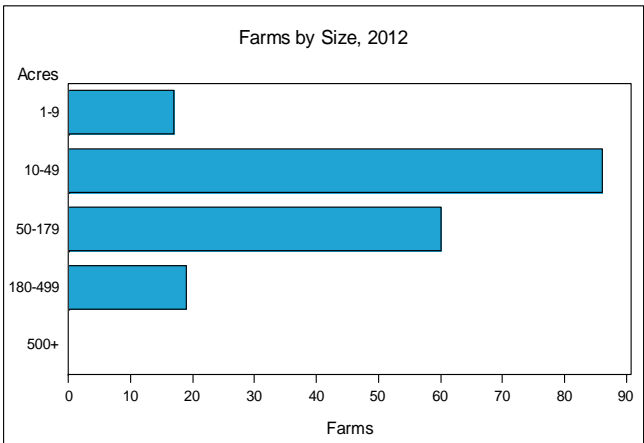

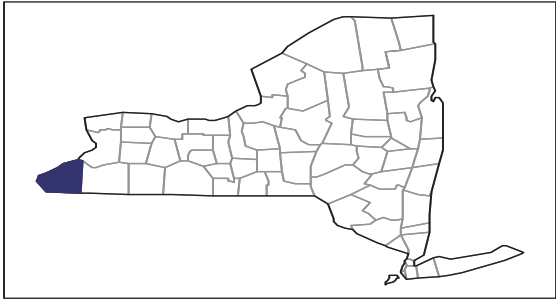

### Chautauqua County - New York Farms with Spanish, Hispanic, or Latino Operators Compared with All Farms



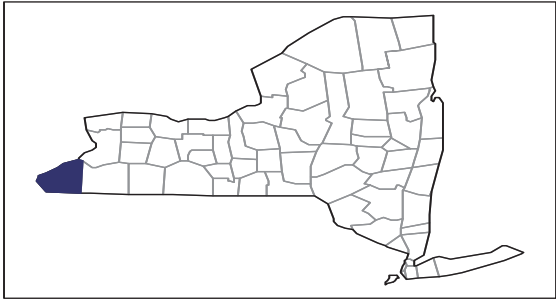

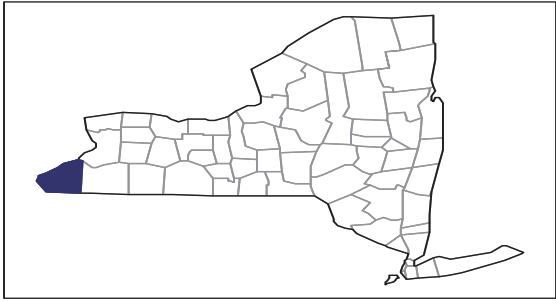

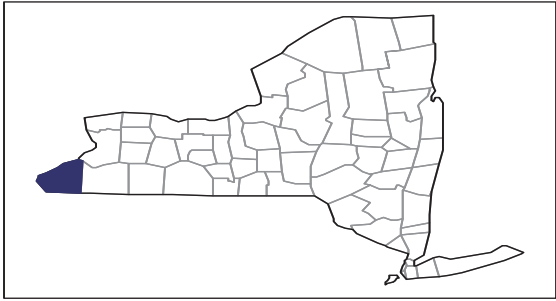

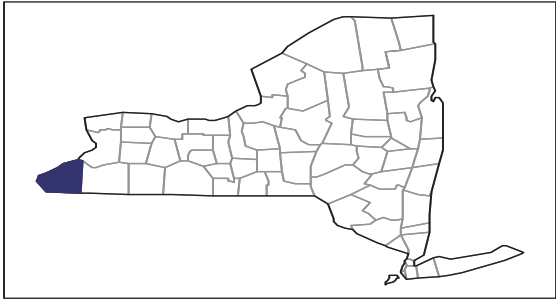

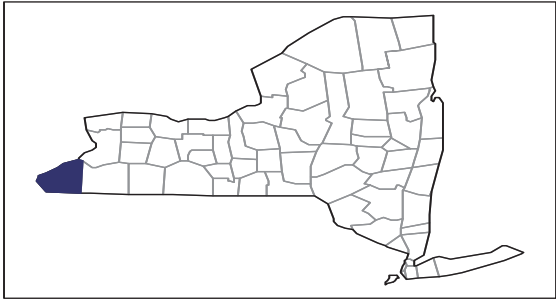
