




Pitt County - North Carolina Farms with Spanish, Hispanic, or Latino Operators Compared with All Farms






Pitt County - North Carolina Farms with American Indian or Alaska Native Operators Compared with All Farms








## Pitt County - North Carolina Farms with Asian Operators Compared with All Farms






Pitt County - North Carolina Farms with Black or African American Operators Compared with All Farms








Pitt County - North Carolina Farms with Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander Operators Compared with All Farms
