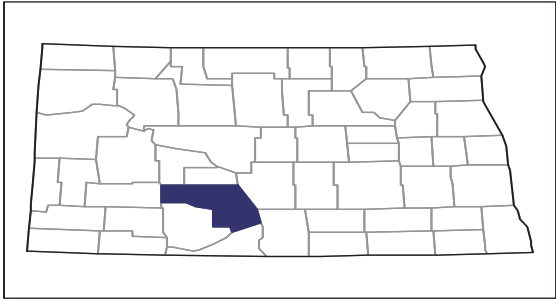

### Morton County - North Dakota Farms with Spanish, Hispanic, or Latino Operators Compared with All Farms



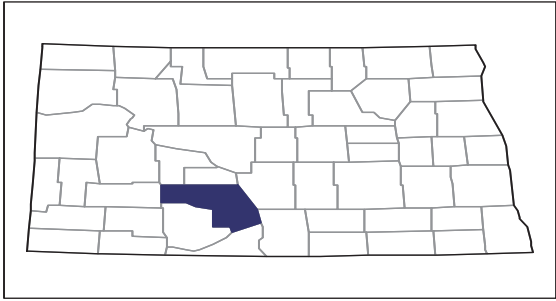

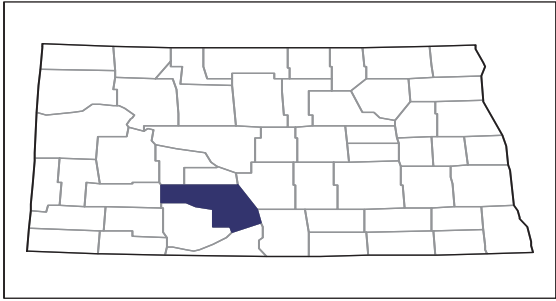

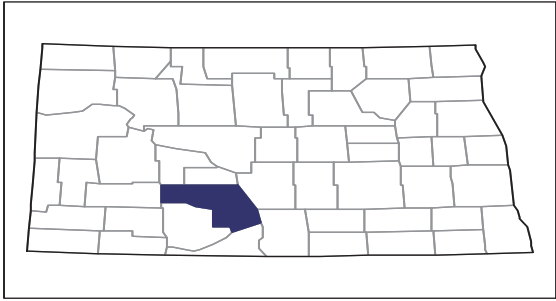

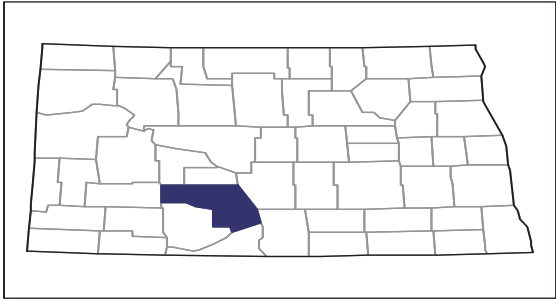

### Morton County - North Dakota Farms with Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander Operators Compared with All Farms



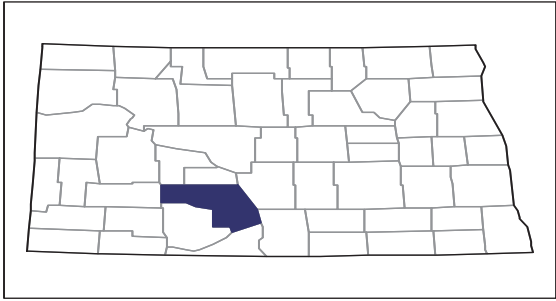
