### Lincoln County - Oklahoma Farms with Asian Operators Compared with All Farms



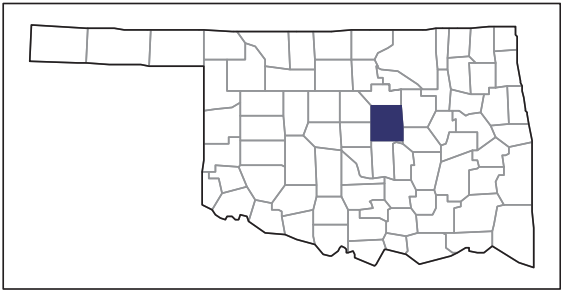

### Lincoln County - Oklahoma Farms with Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander Operators Compared with All Farms

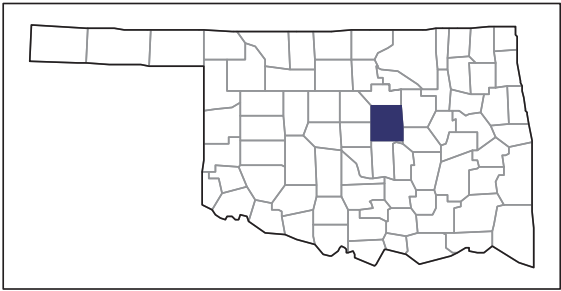

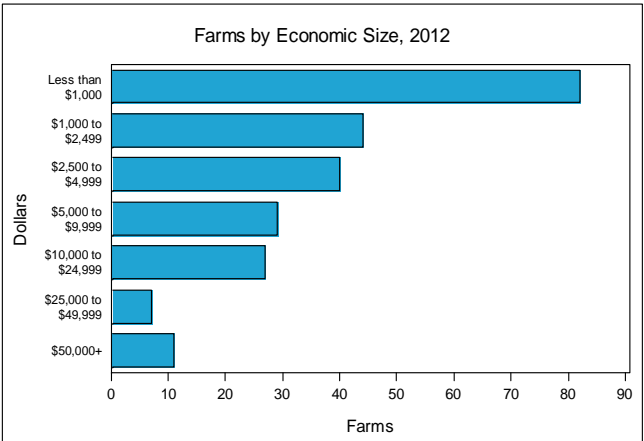
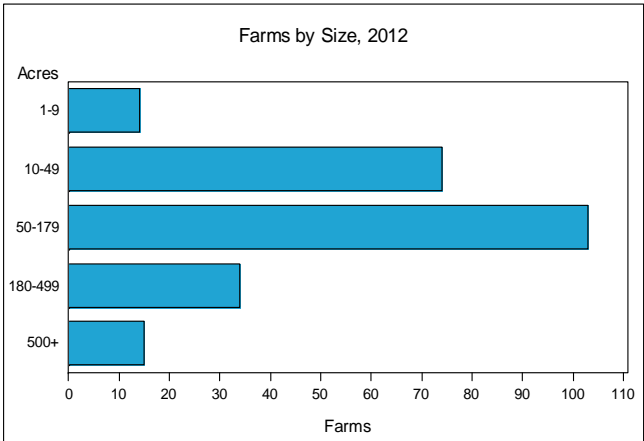
