




Grant County - West Virginia Farms with Spanish, Hispanic, or Latino Operators Compared with All Farms



Grant County - West Virginia Farms with American Indian or Alaska Native Operators Compared with All Farms



## Grant County - West Virginia Farms with Asian Operators Compared with All Farms



### Grant County - West Virginia Farms with Black or African American Operators Compared with All Farms



Grant County - West Virginia Farms with Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander Operators Compared with All Farms


