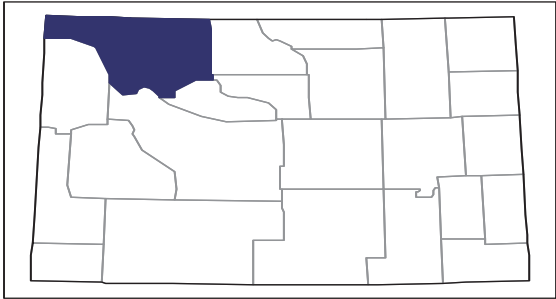

Park County - Wyoming Farms with American Indian or Alaska Native Operators Compared with All Farms

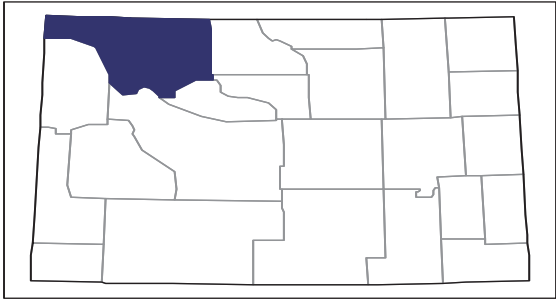

with All Farms**

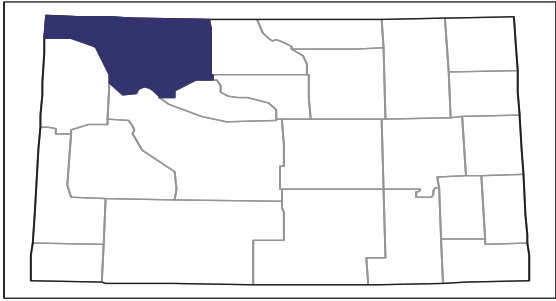

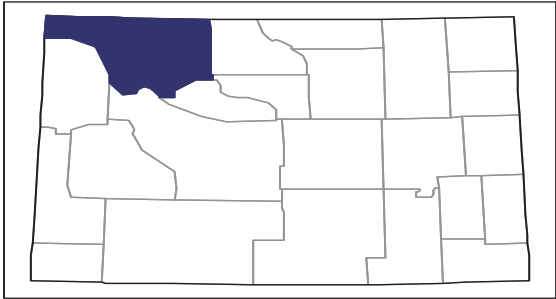

Park County - Wyoming Farms with Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander Operators Compared with All Farms

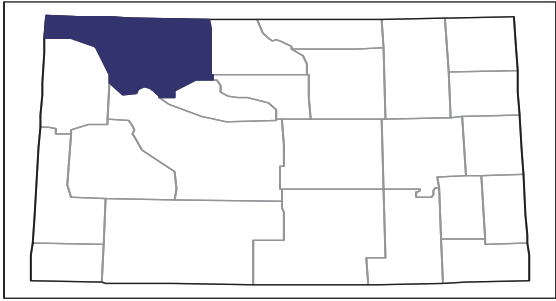
